Thank you for your enquiry for the position of Floating Community Play Ranger This is a zero hours contract to cover for staff holidays and sickness. The job is working outside in parks across Bath with children aged 5 – 13 years providing play opportunities including den making, fires, football, crafts, cooking, strap lines and much more.

During the Summer holidays we will also be running some community play events including Mini Playdays with the Community Play Rangers and holiday play sessions for children and families aged 5 – 12 years. These will run from 28th July until 27th August.

Closed-access holiday playschemes take place at Three Ways school in Odd Down, Bath for children aged 5 - 19 years. Inclusive holiday playschemes take place at the Hut for disabled and non-disabled children aged 5 - 12 years.

Family Play sessions will take place at a variety of locations across Bath.

Working as part of a team, staff are expected to facilitate a range of age appropriate play opportunities using a variety of different spaces within the school, both inside and outside

Playwork can be extremely hard work but the children get an enormous amount of pleasure from playing with peers, having a fun and enjoyable time in the school holidays.
