The post-holder will lead on developing, managing and delivering play and family support services in Bath and the surrounding area, liaising and negotiating as required with schools and other partners. This will involve managing a year round staff team, supporting staff at playschemes during most school holidays and also working with others to improve children's opportunity for play within family, school and community settings and to assist in securing external funding where necessary. Previous experience of managing successful play services and of staff management is essential.

The successful candidate will have business development and presentation skills, ability to write reports and analyse data, and experience of managing both playworkers and temporary sessional play staff. The contract is for 37 hours per week, including working flexible hours which may vary occasionally involving weekends, evenings and early mornings.

The successful candidate will need to be a team player with strong management, leadership, IT and communication skills. He/she must be able to maintain professional and productive relationships with colleagues and partners.
