#### **6) Street Light project** (8003/10/19)

Tenders have been sent to four potential lighting contractors. The deadline for replies is the 18<sup>th</sup> October, with tenders being reviewed on the 22<sup>nd</sup> October.

#### **7) Library project update** (8004/10/19)

There has been agreement reached between the Library and the Dosca/DPC working party. Work to commence in the new year.

#### 8) Road Safety complaints (8005/10/19)

Numerous complaints were received this month regarding road safety on Littleworth Rd, Middlebrook Rd, Hithercroft Rd. An analysis of the SID data was reviewed. One SID is in place on Littleworth Rd, the other one is being repaired. The Council continues to do everything within in its powers to promote road safety.

LAF applications and TFB consultations were discussed. TFB have altered the submissions made by the Council, the Council decided to formally request the original plans were adhered to, the Clerk will contact TFB.

#### 9) Community Governance Review (8006/10/19)

The Council have responded formally to the Community Governance review.

#### **10) Parking Enforcement** (8007/10/19)

Parish Councils have the option to employ the services of private organisation to patrol the highway and enforce parking rules. Cllr Burslem will look into this and update the Council on the practicalities of doing this.

#### **11) Planning applications** (8008/10/19)

**A)** 19/07096/FUL- **5 Faulkner Way-** Householder application for construction of single storey rear extension replacing existing conservatory building (Retrospective)- The property is outside AONB & Conservation Area. The (proposed) works are not visible from road, so will not impact the streetscene.

DPC note that the comments are to a retrospective application and it's disappointing that due process has not been followed. There is also concern that the application states it is a replacement of a conservatory but the photos in the application look like a brick extension.

- **B**) 19/07108/FUL- **5 Court Close-** Householder application for construction of single conservatory to side elevation- No concerns.
- It is not felt that the proposed plans will materially impact neighbouring properties or be out of keeping with the area
- C) 19/07128/TPO- **42 South View-** Cut back a number of thin branches to 1 x Beech as there a number of thin branches overhanging into the garden- Refer to arborist.
