# Weekly roadworks update

As part of Buckinghamshire Council's £100m investment in roads across the county over the next four years, work will be taking place next week at the following locations through Transport for Buckinghamshire's Strategic Highway Maintenance Programme.

Some activities are extremely weather dependent, therefore dates shown are subject to change at short notice. These dates may also be subject to change depending on the availability of materials and the effects of COVID-19 on supply chain partners.

No weekend working unless specified.

Conventional Resurfacing Improvement Schemes

London Road, Aston Clinton – From Upper Icknield Way to Lower Icknield Way (Monday 15 August to Friday 26 August)

*Conventional resurfacing works using a road closure in operation Monday to Friday between 8:00pm to 6:00am.* 

Avenue Road, Winslow – From High Street to Road Narrows (Friday 26 August) Conventional resurfacing works using a road closure in operation Monday to Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm.

Charndon to Marsh Gibbon (Main Street), Marsh Gibbon – From Charndon to Castle Street (Tuesday 23 August)

We will be carrying out a final sweep on the road to remove any loose or excess chipping, applying a final coating to seal the initial treatment and reinstating the road markings using a road closure in operation Monday to Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm.

Kimblewick Road, Kimblewick – From Stockwell Lane to Lower Icknield Way (Friday 26 August)

We will be carrying out a final sweep on the road to remove any loose or excess chipping, applying a final coating to seal the initial treatment and reinstating the road markings using a road closure in operation Monday to Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm.

## Failed Road Schemes:

Shipton Lee, Edgcott – From Perry Hill to Clayton Road (Saturday 27 August) We will be carrying out a sweep to remove any loose chipping from the road, applying a sealant to the new road surface and reinstating the road markings. These works will take place on Saturday 27 August using a road closure in operation 7:00am to 7:00pm. Chapel Lane, Akeley – From Akeley Road to Lillingstone Road (Monday 22 August) We will be carrying out a final sweep on the road to remove any loose or excess chipping, applying a final coating to seal the initial treatment and reinstating the road markings using a road closure in operation Monday to Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm. Heet Road, Marsh Gibbon – From Spiers Lane to A41 (Wednesday 24 August) We will be carrying out a final sweep on the road to remove any loose or excess chipping,

applying a final coating to seal the initial treatment and reinstating the road markings using a road closure in operation Monday to Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm.

Marsh Gibbon Road, Marsh Gibbon – From Marsh Gibbon cricket club to Grendon Road (Thursday 25 August)

We will be carrying out a final sweep on the road to remove any loose or excess chipping, applying a final coating to seal the initial treatment and reinstating the road markings using a road closure in operation Monday to Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm.

## Drainage Improvement Schemes

Hivings Hill, Chesham (Monday 4 July to Wednesday 31 August) Drainage improvement works using a combination of two-way and three-way temporary traffic lights in operation Monday to Friday between 7:00am until 5:00pm.

## Network Safety Schemes:

Hatters Lane, High Wycombe – From Wingate Avenue to Windrush Drive (Monday 8 August to Wednesday 7 September)

Installation of a new signalised pedestrian crossing using two-way temporary traffic lights in operation Monday to Friday between 8:30am to 4:30pm.

## Bridge Schemes:

High Street, Marlow – Marlow Bridge (Tuesday 5 October 2021 to Friday 25 November 2022)

Major bridge refurbishment using a footway closure when appropriate in operation Monday to Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm.

## Highway Infrastructure Projects (HIPs):

A41 Bicester Road - Rabans Lane to Paradise Orchard including Jackson Road and Dickens Way, Aylesbury

Work will continue on the Eastbound and Westbound near Jackson Road/Dickens Way junctions with narrow lanes whilst construction of two traffic islands and footway works are undertaken. Works will be undertaken daytime and two-way traffic flow will be maintained at all times along the A41.

The reason for both Jackson Road & Dickens Way to remain closed is purely for safety reasons due to the change in configuration of the junction from a roundabout to a signal-controlled junction. During this time our workforce will be required to install new cabling and traffic signals. It is imperative that the safety of our workforce and both residents and travelling members of the Public remain paramount during these works. As such the existing diversion routes for both Jackson Road and Dickens Way will remain in place until the 2 September 2022. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused, but please be assured we are working to deliver the project as safely and quickly as possible.
