- Dyke clear out, this is being done shortly, the hedge has been cut
- Willow tree coppicing tidying up and pond group formation, nothing to report
- Pond clear out of reeds has been postponed until November as disturbance of the crested newt habitat in the breeding season is unlawful. Clerk to contact Simon Hall of Hagrapat to arrange, Clerk has requested that the grant to do the job is held over until November. The Conservation Volunteers have made a grant application to enable training of volunteers and results of this will be known in November
- Dog fouling pilot scheme, waiting for course dates
- Aughton Church grass cutting costs to be investigated for 2015
- Bonfire insurance, Clerk will fill out the form saying the DTI guidelines will be adhered to and this will validate the insurance
- Standing orders were amended to include recording of meetings
- Defibrillator, Clerk explained that an application to the East Riding of Yorkshire Local Grant Fund could be made for this equipment, it was resolved to make an application for this as well as salt for severe weather needs
- 30 mph speed limit proposals for Aughton were supported
