

Rose : one bloom 2. Roses : three blooms in one vase 3. Roses : six blooms in one container, two or more cultivars 4. Roses, cluster-flowered, one stem, one Cluster flowered roses include floribunda. rambler, polyantha, cluster-flowered climbers vase etc. 5. Roses, cluster flowered, three stems, one vase 6.
