The voice of a London Christian woman living with HIV:

"I chose, right from the beginning of my diagnosis, to keep it confidential and it has remained so..."

"I was judged, I was thrown out, I would speak to Imams and privately it was all OK. We'll take care of you and support you...but publically you would see people behaving [differently]... and avoiding you."
