## CONSTITUTION

NAME: The Association shall be known as FEERING AND KELVEDON GARDEN CLUB

(changed at AGM 1996 from FEERING AND KELVEDON HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY)

AIMS: 1. To promote happy fellowship among gardeners.

- 2. To provide for a winter and summer session of meetings, excursions, visits, etc.
- 3. To organise shows each year.
- 4. To make provision for help in all gardening matters.
- 5. To carry out any such other activities as may be of value to the members.
- 6. To maintain affiliation with the Royal Horticultural Society.

MEMBERSHIP: 1. Anyone interested in any aspect of gardening and plant growing shall be eligible

for membership on payment of the annual subscription.

2. Honorary members may be elected at a General Meeting.

OFFICERS: 1. The Club's Officers shall be:- (1) President (2) Vice-President(s) (both elections for life)

(3) Chairman (4) Vice-Chairman (5) Secretary (6) Treasurer

(7) Assistant Secretary (8) Programme Organiser (9) Outings Organiser (10) Membership Secretary

2. All Officers, save 1 & 2, shall be elected for one year at the Annual General Meeting.

Only Officers 3, 4, 5 & 6 shall be ex-officio members of all committees. Officers 7, 8, 9 or 10
may be elected to the Executive Committee or attend meetings of committees at will or if
required

COMMITTEES: 1.

- The Executive Committee shall consist of the ex-officio Officer members & six ordinary members. Officers 7, 8, 9 & 10 may be elected as ordinary committee members with specific functions to perform.
- All ordinary members of Committee shall be elected for one year at the Annual General Meeting. Retiring members shall be eligible for nomination and re-election.
- 3. The Committee may co-opt members to fill vacancies, or for any other sufficient reason.
- 4. A quorum for the Committee shall be six persons, of which two must be ordinary members
- 5. Any Committee member who has **missed three consecutive meetings without prior apology**shall be deemed to have resigned & shall be so informed by the Secretary
- Sub-committees may be formed for specific purposes, such as running the Show, but only with
  the prior approval of either the membership at the Annual General Meeting or the Executive
  Committee at other times. Such sub-committees shall submit reports as necessary to the
  Executive Committee, which shall regularly monitor, authorise & minute their proceedings

FINANCE:

- 1. Ordinary members shall pay an **annual subscription** to be set at the Annual General Meeting.
- 2. Funds may be raised for the Club through other activities organized by the Committee.
- 3. In the event of the Club ceasing to exist, any balance of funds shall be transferred to

Perennial, the Gardeners' Royal Benevolent Society.

DUTIES OF

The Treasurer

TREASURER 1. shall be responsible for all the Club's financial matters.

- 2. shall deposit with a bank prescribed by the Committee all the Club's negotiable assets.
- 3. may hold in cash such amounts of the Club's funds as may be necessary.
- 4. shall effect such insurances for the Club as the Committee may direct.
- 5. shall **submit the Club accounts** to an **independent examiner** approved by the AGM.
- 6. shall **submit a financial statement & balance sheet** at the Annual General Meeting.

GENERAL MEETINGS 1. An **Annual General Meeting** shall be held after a period not exceeding fifteen months.

2. A **Special General Meeting** may be called either by the Committee at any time

or on the written request of any six members.
