#### 080/2025 Public Participation Session

The Chairman will invite questions and observations from members of the public present.

Can the Parish Council help with any donation for the village hall? An acoustic for the village hall is about £1000. Improvements total about £7000. The Chair stated that the village hall committee is doing very well. The Clerk asked the village hall representative to submit a grant application form before the November meeting so Councillors can look at the 2026-2027 budget.

Can yellow lines be painted at the junction of Claypits Lane? This is a highways issue.

Can an article be placed in the Parish magazine requesting parking in Claypits Lane to more vigilant in parking towards residents in the lane?

**081/2025** Councillors' old Gmail email accounts being ceased – update from Cllr M. Posen The Clerk to contact Karl at Macintosh Electronics to move all Gmail emails across to .gov.uk emails.

**082/2025** Local Government reorganisation - to discuss the possibility of joining with Suffolk rather than Essex. Cllr K. Holmes

There is precedent to change Parish Council boundary. Foxearth is more closely aligned with Suffolk CC. Borley Parish Council wishes to remain with Braintree District Council. Foxearth & Liston Parish Council cannot undertake this change on its own. With this process it is more unlikely to go ahead. This item to be removed from future agendas

### 083/2025 Footpath update – Cllr K. Robson

A farm track has been put down with hardcore at Oak Lodge. Cllr K. Robson has walked the route with the PROW officer. This issue has been reported to BDC Enforcement team who have visited the site but could not find it. Cllr K. Holmes has supplied the enforcement officer with the correct location. After another visit the enforcement officer have decided it is not a breach of planning. Foot bridges that are defective have been reported to Essex Highways but was informed that they are not a top priority.

#### 084/2025 Highway issues

• Speed Indicator Device (SID) – Update, traffic report and further actions – Cllr M. Posen Cllr M. Posen circulated the results from 6<sup>th</sup>. July to 7<sup>th</sup>. September

F&LPC's Speed Indicator Device (SID) was installed outside Foxearth Hall on 26th May 2025. The SID collects data regarding the speed and amount of traffic passing the sign. It only monitors traffic entering the village towards the sign from the Cavendish end and does not monitor traffic leaving the village away from the sign.

This report summarises the traffic data collected in the period 8 July to 7 September 2025 (9 weeks).

Key highlights of the traffic data are:

- Vehicle count in the period: **44,469** (previous 6 weeks: 40,492)
- Average daily vehicle count: 795 (previous 6 weeks: 953)
- Average speed of vehicles passing the SID: 27.5 mph (previous 6 weeks: 27.7 mph)
- Maximum speed passing the SID: **60mph** (previous 6 weeks: 65 mph)
- Percentage of vehicles exceeding the 30mph limit: **29%** (previous 6 weeks: 30%)
- Percentage of vehicles exceeding 35mph: **6%** (previous 6 weeks: 6%)

I will continue to monitor traffic passing the SID and will submit a report to each Parish Council meeting. My recommendations remain unchanged from the July meeting.

It maybe beneficial to start the Speedwatch team up again. Could an article be placed in the Parish magazine?
