I refer to your public question that you submitted to the March 2024 meeting of the Heatons and Reddish Area Committee relating to the "Peel Moat Open Space".

I have now been advised that: -

The Council approved plan for Peel Moat Open Space is due to commence in April 2024. I am therefore seeking written assurance on behalf of the Friends of Peel Moat Open space that despite the site being designated as " developable " in the extant SHLAA (https://www.stockport.gov.uk/strategic-housing-land-availability-assessment-shlaa/land-availability-map) that the site will not be sold for housing or any other form of development.

We have reviewed the current status of the Peel Moat site as requested by the questioner and there are no current plans to develop or dispose of this site for any purpose. The council has made no formal commitments on the future uses of this parcel of land.
