

Friends of Rising Sun Country Park Minutes of the Meeting held on 11th April 2025

After the apologies were noted, the Minutes of the March meeting were accepted as a true record.

Tree Planting:

- NTC have agreed to purchase more Mulch mates.
- The Woodland Trust has approved our application for another 420 trees. Arrive date November.
- Maintenance of the trees already planted is ongoing and will be combined with a litter pick. Claire was able to confirm that some of the trees do now have leaves.

Brass-Rubbing Plaques/Interpretation Board:: The committee agreed to purchase 4 of the brass plates showing different types of leaves and 5 of the resin plagues (4 wildlife and one the RSCP logo). Education Team will be asked to select the 4 wildlife plaques (AP1)

Regarding the Interpretation Board more discussion is needed to agree the content of the board once the plaques agreed. (AP2). NTC and the Outdoor Education Team to have final approval on new board design.

AGM preparation: Claire has scanned all relevant documents . Eric confirmed that he has all the relevant financial documents

Perspex Artwork Screens:Electrical safety checks have been carried out so we now have the go ahead to put up the display. Claire agreed to clean the screens (**AP3**) and Eric will drill the necessary holes (**AP4**). NTC still need to agree to the final display before they can be erected. Vivien agreed to write a short note to be displayed with the artwork explaining their history. (**AP5**)

Plan: Amanda W has made a few amendments to the plan to make sure people can clearly see deadlines and identify ongoing work. Janet C asked if a smiley face could be used on the plan to show completed activities. Amanda agreed to trail the use of smiley faces. **(AP6)**

Treasurer's Report: The Final End of Year Accounts have been completed. Eric confirmed that there is an end of year surplus of £355 giving total end of year balance of £4885.67
