## What is ERAL?

The Lancashire Emergency Radio Area Link (ERAL) is an interoperability radio platform designed on resilience principles. It enables all Lancashire Category 1 and 2 responders (and their authorised partners) to communicate with each other during an emergency, on a common VHF radio network. Agencies can access this facility from their own radio equipment on common frequencies.

ERAL also has capability in digital mode to provide encrypted secure communication over voice and text. It has full coverage/capability across Lancashire and partial cross-border coverage into Cumbria, Yorkshire, and Merseyside.
