

## Scarecrow Competition

For one week in June as part of Galleywood Festival, organisers are holding a scarecrow competition, which means that everyone can make a scarecrow and display it in their front garden.

If you don't have anywhere to display your scarecrow, you can ask a friend or neighbour, or organisers will try to help.

The aim is to have fun and create street-craft for everyone to enjoy and to give us all something to smile about.

Making a scarecrow is relatively easy and affordable. Scarecrows don't mind if you dress them in hand-me-downs or clothes from a charity shop. Organisers hope that families will get involved together to create their own unique scarecrow.

As well as traditional scarecrows, we hope to see some imaginative ones modelled on characters from public life, books, film or tv. The more diverse your ideas, the more fun we will all have.

### Important points to note:-

Scarecrows need to be on display from Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June until Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> June within the parish of Galleywood.



To enter the competition, go to [www.galleywood.org](http://www.galleywood.org) and complete a registration form, otherwise your scarecrow will not be judged and considered for a prize.

Your scarecrow will need to be mounted securely so that it stands up safely for the whole week of the festival.

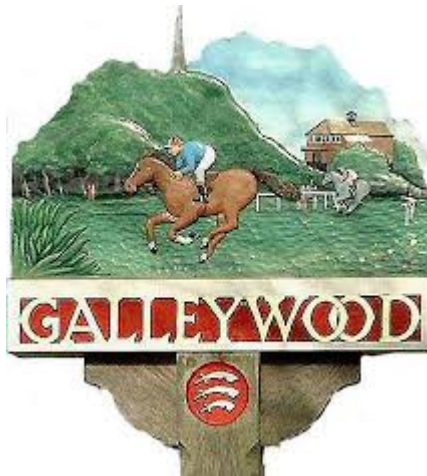
