

World War 1: The "Christmas Truce" begins - several brief unofficial cessation of hostlities occurred on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day between German and British or French troops, particularly between British and German troops stationed along the Western Front.

Long before Jesus was born Isaiah said:

"A child is born to us! A son is given to us!..... He will be called..... Prince of Peace."

Micah said "He will bring us peace" and at his birth angels sang "Glory to God in the highest heaven and peace on earth."

In this centenary year of the beginning of The Great War we look back to December 1914, where there was no peace for the British forces, who thought that fighting would be over by Christmas.

On Christmas Eve 1914 some British forces stood facing the German army, separated by a strip of land called 'no-man's land.' The air was cold and frost-filled, when suddenly, amazed British soldiers saw lights come on along the line of enemy trenches. Then came the unbelievable sound of singing – German soldiers singing 'Silent Night, Holy Night'. When the sound faded away the British soldiers replied with 'The First Nowell'.

The singing by both sides went on for an hour and was followed by invitations to cross over to enemy lines. One courageous German began to walk across to the British trenches, followed by other Germans, hands in pockets, to show that they had no weapons.

When Christmas Day dawned bright and cold there was no sound of rifles or gunfire. The men had agreed among themselves to declare peace, and even played a game of football. "A spirit stronger than war was at work that night," one onlooker commented.

One British soldier who took part in that memorable Christmas peace died in 1981 at the age of 85. Until the end of his life he could not listen to the singing of Silent Night without tears streaming down his face as he remembered the German friends he made that Christmas.

Peace at Christmas and best wishes for 2015 to all in Great Horwood and Singleborough. Everyone is welcome at our Christmas services and to join in the carol singing. From all at St. James'.

#### Message from PCSO Wendy Taylor

#### **Burglary dwelling**

The figures for burglaries from homes remain at zero. This is very good news and, hopefully, shows that the crime prevention advice we have been giving is being listened to and acted upon. I would like to stress however, that we should not be complacent. The nights are drawing in and, therefore, houses could be in darkness for longer. So please remember to use timer switches on lights and radios. Ensure your house is secure when you leave it and your locks are robust. Remember to check any doors to conservatories are locked properly, ie lift the handle before turning the lock. The same applies to UPVC front doors. Invest in window locks and ensure windows are closed before leaving the house. Please contact the Winslow and District Neighbourhood team via 101 (phone) if you would like further information.

#### **Driving safely**

It's that time of year again when the clocks have gone back, the nights are drawing in and the weather becomes a challenge; particularly for those who drive. This is, therefore, a gentle reminder

- check your tyres for wear and correct pressure.
- ensure all your lights work and that your headlights are correctly aligned so you do not inadvertently dazzle oncoming drivers. I would also like to point out that the use of fog lights, both front and rear, when there is no fog is illegal. Fog lights should not be used if visibility is greater than 100 metres - visibility is rarely less than this. They are designed to be bright in fog, therefore they dazzle when visibility is good. They should also not be used if it is raining.
- ensure your windows are clean and clear before you set off on your journey.
- ensure your wipers function correctly and the rubber section is sound. If not, replace them.

Most importantly, adverse driving conditions require that you drive at a slower speed than the limit on the road. Speed limits are not goals so do not be tempted to drive faster than you think is safe

# Chairman's Monthly Report Last Meeting – Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2014

Neighbourhood Plan

By the time this is published the hearing by an independent examiner on the Great Horwood Neighbourhood Development Plan will have taken place on 27th November and we will be waiting for the examiner's decision on whether or not the plan can proceed to a referendum by all of the registered electors in the Parish.

At the time of writing this article we know that the examiner has called all of the developers and all of the residents who submitted written objections to the plan during the publicity period to also make verbal representations at the hearing.

#### Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan

The Council approved a submission to the consultation on the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan (VALP) with a detailed argument that Great Horwood cannot be considered a "large" village within the settlement hierarchy defined by AVDC as it does not have many of the facilities required to match the definition.

A Planning Inspector has allowed an appeal by a developer for 47 homes in Aston Clinton and as part of the judgement decided that AVDC has only enough planning consents to meet the needs of the Vale for next 4.3 years and so is well short of the 5 years required by the government. This means that there is now an automatic presumption in favour of approving planning applications. AVDC subsequently approved an application for 85 homes at Tingewick. However, a Neighbourhood Plan is one of the factors that must be taken into account when considering such planning applications.

AVDC expect that it will need to include planning for 1000 homes per annum for its own local requirements for the next 20 years and between 200 and 500 per annum for the needs of other districts which do not have a sufficient land supply of their own. The VALP is not expected to be adopted until mid 2017.

#### Defibrillator for the Village

At our meeting we confirmed the go ahead to install a defibrillator on the outside wall of the village hall. Cllr. Mayne is going to contact Winslow and Buckingham Town Councils to find out who installed their devices.

#### Singleborough Notice Board

The replacement notice board has been installed in Singleborough.

#### Gypsy Site in Nash Road

This site was given temporary planning consent in 2011 and this consent is due to expire in November 2015. However AVDC still does not have a policy for the accommodation of Gypsies and Travellers as required by law and does not have any proposed sites to meet the identified needs of Gypsies and Travellers. A meeting has been arranged with AVDC councillors Cllr Neil Blake, Cllr Paternoster and Cllr Stanier and AVDC officers Tracey Aldworth and Andy Kirkham to discuss the future of the site. I will be attending together with Cllr. Scholtens and representatives of Nash Parish Council.

#### Village Green Legal Position

Legal advice has confirmed that because the area within The Green is registered as a "Village Green" it cannot be disturbed unless it is for the benefit of everyone. The Council has therefore advised Anglian Water that it must find an alternative route for its replacement water main.

#### Flooding on The Green

At our meeting we approved a quote to carry out the installation of a soak-away in the corner of The Green nearest to The Crown in order to reduce the risk of flooding in this area. Although this work is on the "Village Green" our legal advice is that it is permissible as it is for the benefit of everyone.

#### **Planting Winter Planters**

The planters at the entrances to the parish have been restocked with winter flowering plants.

#### Lord of the Manor

Dean White and I have received an email from D Jack Smith, the Lord of the Manor, to advise that as he has now retired and has some health problems he will not be continuing with his annual award of a donation to village projects. Both Dean and I wrote back to thank him for his generous support over the years and especially his donation in 2012 which made our Diamond Jubilee Celebrations so successful.






