# Future Development in Great Horwood: Residents Drop-in session held on Sunday 12th January



Great Horwood residents were out in force, eating cake, drinking tea and coffee and discussing the future of the place they call home.

Villagers were there from 11am on the dot; we had over 80 households from all over the village come through the doors.

The outcome of this? Most are resigned to building. The Vale of Aylesbury Plan has just been thrown out by the powers above so who knows what happens now? But this we do know: the villagers would much prefer the Planning Team with the support of the Parish Council to get on and form a plan that keeps the integrity of Great Horwood for generations to come. By this we mean smaller scale developments and affordable housing with locals in mind, dotted about the village in other

appropriate areas as well as Weston Road over the 20 years originally asked of us, not the 40-55 houses that Taylor Wimpey want to build in one place now with 35% of that going to social housing.

Over 86 people signed a letter asking Mr Bill Nicholson, the Area Planning Manager at AVDC, to consider delaying

planning permission to Taylor Wimpey in favour of the work of our own Neighbourhood Planning Team (NPT). A copy of this letter and the signatures has been sent to Sir Beville Stanier who is Great Horwood's Ward of Parliament and Kris Hopkins the Housing Minister.

On another note we have a parishioner willing to join the NPT from Spring Lane, and 7 volunteers to form a committee in favour of the possibility of a community shop, so is there anyone else who'd like add their name to that list?



# Chairman's Monthly Report Last Meeting – Monday 9th December 2013

# Neighbourhood Plan

Since my last report in the December edition of Focus the Great Horwood Neighbourhood Planning Team has had 2 meetings and the minutes are published on the Parish Council website

In the meantime as I am sure you have all read that a Planning Inspector has rejected the Vale of Aylesbury Plan as submitted by AVDC on 2 main counts:-

- The housing and job numbers in the plan.
- The duty to cooperate with adjacent local authorities.

The lack of a current up-to-date plan for Aylesbury Vale will now almost certainly lead to a large number of speculative applications by landowners and developers thus creating a free for all with the inevitable result that we will eventually get many more houses built in the Vale than if AVDC had managed to put in place a reasonable and acceptable plan based on its research over the last 3 - 4 years.

We have been told that over 80 people attended the open session in the village hall on Sunday the 12th January and that there was widespread support for the Neighbourhood Planning Team to continue with the work of producing a Neighbourhood Plan.

At our meeting on 14th January the team agreed to continue with its work on the understanding that without a new Vale of Aylesbury Plan in place it is even more important than ever that we have a Neighbourhood Plan. We believe that this can still be achieved even in the absence of a Vale of Aylesbury Plan.

We decided that we should continue to resist large scale development and also developments of large expensive houses and continue to support developments which are appropriate in terms of scale and location and that consist of low cost/affordable smaller family homes. To this end we decided to invite the landowners of sites C, G and A to attend a public meeting to confirm their acceptance of this type of scheme and our consultants would then be available to meet with them for further discussions on more detailed plans.

In the meantime we have been informed by Taylor Wimpey that they have an option from Mr Hanson on site C (at the end of Weston Road). They have also informed us that they will be carrying out a public consultation starting in the week commencing 20th January and we have seen that they have already carried out extensive surveys of the site and surrounding area. We will continue to monitor the way that the Taylor Wimpey proposal develops and if necessary support the Parish Council in opposition to any unsuitable development proposal that they make.

## Movable Vehicle Activated (Speed) Signs (MVAS) Installation

As I am sure that you have seen, the MVAS has been in operation on the Winslow Road entrance to the village since 20th November with short breaks to allow for the batteries to be re-charged. We now have spare batteries so that when the batteries in the unit run down they can be replaced with fully charged ones thus reducing the time that the unit is out of action. Following consultation with local residents, the two additional sites for the movable unit were installed on 13th January at the top of Nash Road adjacent to The Green and in Little Horwood Road at the junction with The Close. This means that we are now able to move the units between the 4 different sites, including the one in Singleborough.

On the 15th January we had training in the village hall on how to download and analyse the data from the unit. Once we have collected this data and can show that many vehicles are speeding as they enter the village at one of the sites we can then ask Thames Valley Police to carry out an exercise to check, stop and prosecute the offenders.

### **Recreation Committee**

Despite the appallingly wet weather that we had over the Christmas period I hope you have had the opportunity to visit Horwode Pece over the last few weeks and seen the new balance triple beam and pods that were installed in November. The funding for this was obtained through a successful

application to the Local Priorities Budget of the BCC Winslow and District Local Area Forum.

# Parish Council Budget and Council Tax for 2014/15

I am sure that you will be pleased to know that the Parish Council has set the same level of precept as for the previous 3 years and so there will be no increase in the Parish Council part of your Council Tax. However, as I write this it seems that both Bucks County Council and AVDC are planning to increase their part of your Council Tax by 1.99%. Under Government rules if they were to increase their Council Tax level by 2.0% or more than they would have to carry out a referendum of all their voters to obtain approval for the rise. So the proposed 1.99% is the maximum available without the need for a referendum.
