

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum on 5th March

As I reported in the December edition of 'FOCUS', the hearing by an independent examiner on the Great Horwood Neighbourhood Development Plan took place on 27th November in the Village Hall. WELL DONE to all those residents who attended the hearing and especially to those who managed to stay throughout the whole 5 hours that the hearing lasted.

The examiner published his report in the first week of January. It is 53 pages long and its conclusion is that subject to certain modifications to the plan that he has proposed, it will meet the 'Basic Conditions' (criteria that the plan must comply with) and can be submitted to referendum.

The examiner's report and the revised plan including the modifications required by the examiner are now available on the Neighbourhood Plan page of the Parish Council website. (http://www.bucksvoice.net/greathorwoodpc/).

I have included below a few quotes from the report:

"The Parish Council are to be commended on the quality of the Neighbourhood Plan produced and submitted for examination."

"From the Consultation Statement (as required by the Regulations) submitted with the Neighbourhood Plan it is clear that the local community were engaged at various times during preparatory work. There were open parish meetings and numerous announcements concerning the development of the Neighbourhood Plan."

"There is also evidence that the Parish Council has pro-actively sought to engage with landowners, their agents and/or developers. Notably a key community engagement event intended to present and seek comments on the Parish Council's preferred sites for the Neighbourhood Plan was broadened out to also include the presentation of alternative sites by their prospective developers."

"In conclusion I am satisfied that the consultation process has been carried out in an open, comprehensive and robust manner."

The Parish Council supports the Neighbourhood Plan but it cannot campaign for any particular outcome to the referendum: **that is a matter for you, the voters in the parish of Great Horwood, to decide.** The Parish Council will, therefore, publish information about the referendum only and leave it to community groups to campaign if they wish to do so.

Your local ambulance service needs you!

Community first responders are volunteers in the community that undergo some training with the ambulance service so that they are able to be a first response to 999 emergency calls. A community first responder's role is to provide basic life support, care and reassurance to a patient and their family between the time of the 999 call and the emergency ambulance arriving.

For every minute a victim of Sudden Cardiac Arrest waits for Basic Life Support and defibrillation, they lose approximately 10 – 20% chance of survival!

Community first responders are a very important part of our team and are a huge benefit to the local community. The training provided covers numerous situations ranging from cardiac arrests, strokes and breathing difficulties to emergency care of infants and Diabetic emergencies. A defibrillator and emergency kit are provided as well as a mobile phone, pager and possible access to a community first responder vehicle.

If you have an interest in emergency medicine, the emergency services and/or your local community a community first responder role may be what you are looking for. 

Chairman's Monthly Report Last Meeting – Monday 8th December 2014

Gypsy Site in Nash Road

On 26th November Cllr Scholtens and I attended a meeting at the offices of AVDC at which the following personnel were present:

Neil Blake, Leader of AVDC; Carole Paternoster, Cabinet Member for Strategic Planning; Sir Beville Stanier; Tracey Aldworth, Director; Susan Kitchen, Manager Development Management; Andy Kirkham, Forward Plans Manager; and three representatives from Nash Parish Council, to discuss the future of the traveller site on the edge of the Parish boundary towards Nash.

It became clear during the discussions that the failure of the Vale of Aylesbury Plan to proceed to a conclusion and the fact that the new Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan is not expected to be adopted until 2017 means that AVDC is no further forward in its plans to identify sites in the district for Gypsies and Travellers as required by current legislation than it was when temporary planning consent was given for the site in Nash Road in November 2011

Therefore, the expectation is that further temporary planning permission will be granted when the current term expires in November of this year and it is even possible that permanent permission could be granted for the current development on the site

Defibrillator for the Village

Cllr Mayne explained the information that she had obtained on the costs involved and the Council unanimously agreed that the order should be placed for the defibrillator to be purchased and installed on the front wall of the Village Hall and be paid for from Parish Council funds

Devolved Services from Bucks County Council (BCC)

Further information has been provided from BCC regarding devolved services including the cutting of the grass verges in the parish and it is obvious that the budget being provided by BCC would not cover the contractor's costs to carry out the works to an acceptable standard. Additional clarification is also needed on how the calculations for the work needed in the Parish has been carried out.

Therefore it was unanimously agreed that we would not participate in any devolved services for the next financial year commencing in April 2015 and the Clerk would write back to BCC confirming this. A decision on taking on responsibility for the services in the following years would be a question for the new Parish Council to be elected in May 2015.

Second Draft of Budget 2015/2016

Prior to the meeting the Clerk circulated the second draft of the budget for Councillors to consider. A small number of amendments had been made and the revised budget was unanimously agreed. The precept that was set will mean that the charge to residents for the Parish Council part of their Council Tax will remain unchanged.




