# Appointment of Rev Dr Stephen O'Connor as the new Rector of St James, Great Horwood in the Winslow Benefice

We are very pleased to announce the appointment of the Reverend Doctor Stephen O'Connor as incumbent of the Winslow Benefice.

Stephen was brought up in the catholic faith and became a committed Christian as a young man which led him to spend some time as a missionary volunteer. After initially starting work in banking, Stephen turned to a career in nursing, where he specialised in palliative care and rose to a senior position. Later, he moved into academia, having gained his PhD, and held various roles including Associate Professor at Maastricht University, Reader at Bedfordshire University, and Reader at Canterbury University in Cancer, and Palliative Care.

After several years, Stephen decided to enter the ministry. He has experienced a wide variety of styles of worship and feels comfortable in all of them. Stephen was appointed as associate incumbent to an Oxford benefice with specific responsibility for social outreach, prayer and faith for a period of three years but realised that he missed the regular, daily interaction with members of a congregation that he had enjoyed as a curate and so applied for our incumbency.

During the interview process we were impressed with Stephen's thoughtful, yet fluent, replies to our questions. He spoke easily during his homily and came across as someone who is intelligent, innovative and, above all, deeply caring for other people. He, and his civil partner, Pascal, are intending to visit us very soon and he is looking forward to taking up his post.

We have confirmed with the Diocese that the Licensing Service, when Stephen will be formally licenced to this post, will take place on

Tuesday 21st February, in St Laurence, Winslow church at 7.30pm.

Stephen's first service at St James Great Horwood will be the following evening,

Ash Wednesday 22nd February at 7.30pm - St James Church







## NOOK PARK RESIDENTIAL PARK HOME SITE

As most of you are aware we have a new site owner at Nook Park. He is Joe Burns of Silk Mill Leisure Ltd, Tring.

If you do not know where Nook Park is, we are at the bottom end of Willow Road. We are now going through a very stressful time. The renters were evicted, their homes destroyed, the garages were demolished and the roofs which contained asbestos was laying on the ground uncovered for six months. Since then, there has been harassment and intimidation from the park owner to some of the residents.

There is a site licence for 25 park homes issued by Buckinghamshire Council. Mr Burns plans to put 32 homes on the site. Some of us have lost our parking spaces due to new plots in readiness for new homes. We now live in a mud bath. Joe Burns has tried to





take parts of our pitches away and still try to increase our pitch fees. We have also lost most of our of our footpaths. Therefore we have only one way off the site by foot via the road which is only tarmacked a short distance. This means one of our residents is severely sight impaired and registered blind has to walk around on the mud as his home is cut off. How is he to get gas, deliveries and his post? We have some residents who have blocked drains since before Christmas. The park owners contractors have not dealt with this completely as one resident has raw sewerage coming from her home. The list is endless, broken water pipes, broken water meters, electricity cables severed, we could go on.

The hedges have been taken up with no regard to wildlife and has made us very exposed to the wind. One of the hedges belonged to a local farmer and therefore the new bases have now encroached onto his land.

We are a quiet vulnerable community. Kettle is always on if you come down and visit.

Please feel free to come down and see us.

We would like to thank Great Horwood and Singleborough for all the support we have had since we have made this public.

If you would like to help us please email or write to Martin Tett at Buckinghamshire Council. We are very desperate for help. The council are dragging their feet as they are investigating Joe Burns. We still have no support from them.

Look forward to meeting more of our village and Singleborough.
