Once again, Winslow Shed was delighted to be able to provide a selection of freshly sharpened and restored carpentry tools for Vron Corben's latest trip to Malawi. The tools will be presented to young trainees at a trade college in the community where Vron has established a much valued and supportive partnership. But with only a standard airline baggage allowance to juggle with, what to take does need careful thought!

The Shed regularly receives donations of old and surplus tools and, while these are gratefully received, the hard truth is that if you already have a good set of (say) chisels then you're all set up - any more are going to gather dust. It is also true that, for us, tools are cheaper and more available than ever before. A new saw these days can cost less than a fiver - it will be razor sharp, effective and will stay that way long enough for it not to matter too much that it cannot be resharpened.

This lack of sustainability is, perhaps, even more the case with power tools where a perfectly usable cordless drill can be picked up with your grocery shop for about the same cost of a takeaway supper. Sustainability comes into sharper focus though when choosing tools that need to earn their keep where there isn't a local B&Q or the option of an Amazon delivery.

To be able to supply a group of eager and deserving young people with sharp, fully restored tools is certainly rewarding and instructive for us and provides a fitting destination for many items that have already given a lifetime of service - they now look set to do it all again!

PARISH PUMP



Great Horwood Parish Council

THE CROWN

It is now 5 years since the The Crown ceased to operate as a public house and since then there have been seven planning or listed building applications made. Two have been withdrawn, 2 have been approved, 2 are awaiting a decision and the latest one has been refused.

Listed Building Application 23/03445/ALB refused on 14 December 2023

"Insufficient information has been submitted to determine whether the proposal would preserve the architectural interest of the listed building."

Since 2020 the Parish Clerk has contacted Buckinghamshire Council Planning Enforcement and the Heritage function a number of times to try to ensure that the current owner is not permitted to allow The Crown to fall into a state of major disrepair. The latest response to the Clerk from the Heritage team which was received on 10th January included the following statement:

"I've spoken to the enforcement team and they are working with our legal team on the best course of action as to which notice we can serve and will be the most effective."

THE SWAN

In 2020 the Parish Council with support from local village organisations applied to register The Swan Public House as an asset of Community Value and this was agreed by Buckinghamshire Council as follows:

"The Council accepts the nomination by Great Horwood Parish Council and includes The Swan Public House, 1 Winslow Road, Great Horwood, Bucks MK17 OQG in its list of assets of community value."

This decision was dated 15th December 2020 and lasts for 5 years and means that the community will have the opportunity to bid for the property if it is sold and gives powers of compulsory purchase if the community use of the asset is in danger of being lost. The possibility of raising enough funds to purchase The Swan and to run it as a community pub would however require significant investment from a large

SPEEDWATCH

I still have only had two volunteers come forward to join me in operating the Speedwatch camera. This is the only method that we have for officially recording the speed of vehicles at fixed points in the parish and from which action can be taken by Thames Valley Police with the information that we feedback to them over the internet.

So if you are really concerned about speeding in the village and worried about the dangers to your children and pets there is something you can do about it.

You will need to undertake an online training course and pass the online test at the end of the course. Once up and running the team will monitor speeds of vehicles at certain agreed spots in the parish and report the details direct to Thames Valley Police who will be able to take warning actions against speeding drivers. 
