# NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN UPDATE

The consultation on the Great Horwood Pre-Submission Neighbourhood Plan finished at 5pm on Monday 9th June. We had a very good response from villagers, with 220 individuals responding as follows:

- 154 in favour of the plan
- 60 against at least part of the plan (of whom 43 signed one petition)
- 6 whose comments could not reasonably be interpreted as either in favour or against

We also had objections from 3 developers as follows:

Gladman Ltd, who would like to build a massive new development of 1200 (yes that is one thousand two hundred) homes on the North side of Winslow. This development would be on the East side of the B4033 starting in Winslow but spreading well into Great Horwood.

Taylor Wimpey, who as you are all aware has already submitted a planning application to build 45 homes on land South of Weston Road.

Progress Planning, who once again raised the possibility of developing land behind 10 to 12 High Street in a development which they call the Paddocks.


All these developers are, of course, concerned that if we are successful in getting our Neighbourhood Plan in place it may well prevent them succeeding with their applications for further developments within the Parish.

The Neighbourhood Planning Team held its 20th meeting on the 18th June in Great Horwood School. It was an open meeting that 27 members of the public attended as well as 5 members of the Neighbourhood Planning team and Neil Homer of rCOH Consultants who has been advising the team on the preparation of the plan. During the meeting Neil presented his report following the end of the consultation period. There was some lively discussion and at the end the Neighbourhood Planning Team unanimously accepted the recommendations contained in Neil's report as follows:

- The policies and supporting text are changed with only minor modifications.
- No site is deleted and no other sites are allocated.
- The Strategic Environmental assessment is modified to take account of changes to the Great Horwood Neighbourhood Plan.
- The Great Horwood Neighbourhood Plan is finalised for submission for examination, subject to the completion of their respective Basic Conditions Statements and Consultation Statements.

The revised plan will be submitted for approval at the Parish Council meeting to be held on Monday 14th July.

#### Message from PCSO Wendy Taylor

Year-on-year burglary in residential outbuildings and sheds in the Winslow and District area has decreased by 80%. But the Neighbourhood Team are not complacent and have carried out an operation last month where we were viewing properties from a thief's point of view and if we saw any vulnerabilities (and we did) we would knock on the door and provide the resident with appropriate crime prevention information.

The crime figures for this area are still good and improving all the time. However, there is one area that we work so hard on in terms of crime prevention advice but still the message is not sinking in. This is **theft from vehicle.** Recently, my colleagues and I attended several and in every case the vehicle was insecure. 'Oh, I just popped in the house for something' or 'I was doing another job but I was in the vicinity of the vehicle' or 'I thought I had locked it but have to admit I did not check it when I left it' are the sort of comments we are getting.

We have to record the fact the vehicle was insecure so if insurance companies check with us they will know the vehicle was not locked so they will not support you. Please take those few minutes to lock your vehicle and check the locking mechanism has worked on all doors, tailgates and boot lids. It could save you a lot of money and effort replacing stolen items. Remember: lethargy is the thief's best friend.

Finally, I will not be attending the 'Have Your say' session on the 2nd of July although that session will still go ahead. However, I can always be contacted on the non-emergency number: 101.



At our meeting on 9th June the Parish Council unanimously voted to object to the above application and an objection letter was subsequently submitted to AVDC.

### Bucks County Council plans to devolve services to parishes

I reported on my attendance at the BCC Parish Devolution Conference of 27th May where Martin Tett, Leader of Bucks CC, explained that as its Government Grant is reduced each year it is necessary to reduce costs and find ever more efficient ways of working.

The proposal was put that parishes should consider taking over the grass cutting within the village 30mph signs for themselves.

We would be given an initial budget of  $\pounds3052$  to carry out the work in Great Horwood but this would be reduced to  $\pounds2058$  from 2016/2017 which obviously means that BCC plan to reduce the number of grass cuts from 6 to 4 at this time. If the parish has taken over this responsibility it would then have to decide whether to reduce the number of cuts per year to carry on with 6 cuts and increase the precept to cover the extra cost.

The only way that it seems possible to move forward with this idea is if we are able to work together with Winslow Town Council and other local parishes.
