VILLAGE HALL

We are now well and truly up and running and have secured regular bookings from an established drama group specialising in Musical Theatre classes, children's birthday parties, and other local bookings not to mention the General Election on July 4th!

We are now planning an official re opening day which will be on Saturday 21st September and will include local invited guests, together with hopefully all the volunteers who so generously gave their time and skills, and this will give us an opportunity to thank all the organisations who gave us financial support.

The refurbishment of the Hall cost around £250,000 and funding came from the Village Hall reserves, a section 106 grant from the development south of

Little Horwood road and from the Parish Council which included a community grant from Low Carbon who installed the Fox Covert solar farm. We also received two direct grants, the first being from the Winslow and Villages Community Board who provided funds for the disabled toilet and secondly one from the Queen's Platinum Jubilee Village Hall fund whose fund is managed by ACRE on behalf of the Department of Environment Food and Rural Affairs. This grant covered 20% of eligible expenditure on the project.

The Trustees' thanks go to all these supporters.

We are still looking for someone special to help with maintaining the Hall for 10 hours per month on a variable rota to suit or perhaps on a job share basis.

HELP HEDGEHOGS IN YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD

According to the State of Britain's Hedgehogs 2022 report, urban hedgehog populations appear to be stabilising and showing signs of recovery, following decades of decline.

This highlights the importance of gardens and green spaces, and local action, in ensuring a future for hedgehogs.

There are plenty of simple ways to help our hedgehogs in our villages in our gardens and green spaces.

The best place to start is to follow 'tips for a hedgehog-friendly garden' :-

1. Link your garden with Hedgehog Highways (checkout www.hedgehogstreet.org)
2. Creating wild areas in the garden
3. Make your pond safe with a ramp
4. Deal with netting and litter
5. Put out supplementary food and fresh water in a shallow dish.
6. Stop using chemicals
7. Check before strimming
8. Make a home for a hedgehog

We are lucky to have masses of working space, room for comfy chairs and a central location where we can connect with our commercial neighbours yet remain accessible for much of the town. This all contributes to our

unique character and a sense that we're playing a small part in making Winslow such a great place to live. We are grateful to Derry French for inviting us to spread the word and have a small display in Church for the St Lawrence Festival in June.

Being part of a National network has its benefits too. UK Men's Sheds have a sponsorship deal with Ronseal and invited all Sheds to submit bids for materials to support them in their community work. We'd almost given up on hearing anything when a courier turned up with a pallet load for us! Thank you Ronseal - you certainly have done what you said you would (on the tin or otherwise!).

Meanwhile, a couple of Sheddies have been exploring exciting ways to secure materials for future projects. We were grateful to receive some large logs from an oak tree that, regrettably, had to be felled for safety reasons. The resulting boards will now need a couple of years to season properly but the beautiful timber is inspiring plenty of ideas already. Even the inevitable lumpy and gnarly chunks - usually firewood - is being visualised as bowls, candlesticks and vases by our woodturners!

Aylesbury Market Bus runs every Friday and Saturday morning. from Winslow, through Gt Horwood, Little Horwood, Mursley and Swanbourne, arriving in Aylesbury just after 10am and departing 12.15pm. FREE with a bus pass, otherwise only £4.50 return. Drop offs at Sainsburys and Broadfields on request.

Winslow Market Service 54abc - runs every Wednesday morning

This service picks up in the surrounding villages and then into Winslow, (Swanbourne, Mursley, Great Horwood, Whaddon, Nash and The Claydons). Pick up times vary according to village. Bus passes accepted, otherwise £3.00 return.

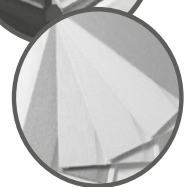
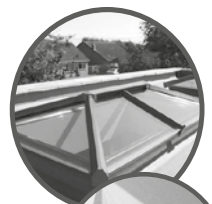
