
Great Horwood Mad March Hare 5k Fun Run - Sunday 5th March

Offenders brought to justice

Thames Valley Police has charged a man with two counts of exposure, one count of sexual assault and one count of violence to secure entry, following three incidents in Buckingham and Winslow.



Greg Laird, aged 29, of Old Station Close, Winslow, was arrested and charged on Monday 17 January.

The charges are in connection with an incident of sexual assault in Winslow on 30 September 2016, an incident of exposure and violence to secure entry in Winslow on 13 November 2016 and an incident of exposure in Buckingham on 1 January.

Laird appeared at Milton Keynes Magistrates Court on 18 January and has been remanded to next appear at Aylesbury Crown Court.

Cyber Crime/Fraud

Payment diversion alert

Fraudsters are emailing members of the public who are expecting to make a payment for property repairs. The fraudsters will purport to be a tradesman who has recently completed work at the property and use a similar email address to that of the genuine tradesman. They will ask for funds to be transferred via bank transfer. Once payment is made the victims of the scam soon realise they have been deceived when the genuine tradesman requests payment for their services.

Protect yourself

- Always check the email address is exactly the same as previous correspondence with the genuine contact.
- For any request of payment via email verify the validity of the request with a phone call to the person who carried out the work.
- Check the email for spelling and grammar as these signs can indicate that the email is not genuine.
- Payments via bank transfer offer no financial protection; consider using alternative methods such as a credit card or PayPal which offer protection and an avenue for recompense

Fake Amazon emails claim you have placed an order

Action Fraud has received several reports from victims who have been sent convincing looking emails claiming to be from Amazon. The spoofed emails from "service@amazon.co.uk" claim recipients have made an order online and mimic an automatic customer email notification. The scam email claims recipients have ordered an expensive vintage chandelier. Other reported examples include: Bose stereos, iPhone's and luxury watches.

The emails cleverly state that if recipients haven't authorised the transaction they can click on the help centre link to receive a full refund. The link leads to an authentic-looking website, which asks victims to confirm their name, address, and bank card information.

Amazon says that suspicious emails will often contain:

- Links to websites that look like Amazon.co.uk, but aren't Amazon.co.uk.
- Attachments or prompts to install software on your computer.
- Typos or grammatical errors.
- Forged (or spoofed) email addresses to make it look like the email is coming from Amazon.co.uk.

If you are ever suspicious about correspondence from your bank you should call the customer serviced number on the back of their card. To report a fraud and cyber crime, call us on 0300 123 2040 or visithttp://www.actionfraud.police.uk/report_fraud

Finally, there has been a spike in cars taken from drives that have been left running to de-ice/ warm up - old cars, new cars, low-spec, high-spec, city, towns and village locations. Some are opportunistic, some are organised but all are preventable and none are claimable against insurance. Please don't learn the hard and expensive way.





Chairman's Monthly Report: Last Meeting - Monday 13 February 2017



Great Horwood

The Parish Council meeting on 13 February began with presentations to Great Horwood Football Club and the Winslow and District Community Bus. Both these organisations, who are recipients of Parish Parish Council Council grants this year, make valuable contributions to the community and it is

good to have an opportunity to put our appreciation of what they do on record. Presentations to the other recipients of this year's grants will be made on other occasions.

We were pleased that both John Chilver, our County Councillor, and Sir Beville Stanier, our District Council Councillor were able to be present at the meeting this month. Indeed, since the meeting, they have each taken up points on the Parish's behalf with their respective councils.

There was the usual round of reports on roadworks, including potholes and pavements, on matters relating to footpaths and on the latest maintenance at Horwode Pece. The continual care which the Horwode Pece Management Committee exercise ensures that this facility remains in good condition for everyone. The Parish Council noted with regret that even more trees have been felled at the Horwood Mill site: this is said to be to enable plans for the proposed houses to be prepared.

A group of residents gave a short presentation about their proposal to replace the phone box on The Green which is being withdrawn from service with a refurbished red Gilbert Scott phone box. The Parish Council will be giving this matter careful consideration.

Turning to planning matters, the most notable item this month was the recent withdrawal of the outline application for up to 34 dwellings at Willow Road. It seems likely that the highway difficulties were a determining factor in this case. The future requirement for housing in the village is once more up in the air as the number of houses required in Aylesbury Vale is again under consideration. The preparation of the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan (VALP), which was already delayed by revised housing need figures issued late last year and the ongoing discussions about the future structure of local government, has been a further set back in the light of the intention to require local authorities to meet 'realistic needs' announced in the recent Government White Paper on housing.

Of more immediate and local concern, the contract for grass cutting in 2017 was agreed. It was also noted and welcomed that a Litter Pick was about to take place which should make the village look neater and tidier. The proposal to install an internet connection in the Village Hall is moving on. Arrangements for the Annual Parish Meeting on 18 May 2017 were also considered.






