

Message from PCSO Wendy Taylor

Vehicle Crime

Again this month we have had to attend thefts from vehicles which were mainly the theft of tools from vans. We know it's a real nuisance to have to empty the van after each day at work, and it is probably the last thing you want to do after a busy day, but we would encourage vehicle owners to remove all valuable items from the vehicle to avoid becoming a victim of this type of crime, along with the extra problems and expense which result. Please mark all of your tools with your house number and postcode. There are 2 benefits to this:

- a) Should police locate stolen items, this will enable positive identification of the property proving that it does not belong to the thief. Without this proof it may be necessary to return possible stolen items back to the suspected thief.
- b) Having recovered stolen items, correct security marking will assist police in returning the property to the rightful owner. Marking can easily be done with an engraver which can be purchased via the internet or any good tool retailer. They are not expensive and could prove to be a good investment. The Winslow & District Neighbourhood policing team are also happy to carry out security marking on property by appointment, and will also be arranging future property marking events in and around Winslow. These events will be published locally.

Bike theft crime prevention advice

The Winslow & District Neighbourhood Policing Team is asking residents to be extra vigilant after a recent spate of thefts of bikes in the Aylesbury area. A number of offences have taken place in gardens, sheds and garages of residential properties as well as public spaces. The team is advising residents to consider the following crime prevention advice:

- Get a good bike lock. Look for the Sold Secure logo on approved locks.
- Always lock your bike at home and when out and about.
- Always lock your bike, even if you're only leaving it for a couple of minutes.
- · If you have guick-release wheels, lock them up as well.
- Remove lights from the bike and take them with you.
- Identify and register your bike using BikeRegister: https://www.bikeregister.com/



Chairman's Monthly Report Last Meeting – Monday 13th October 2014

Neighbourhood Plan

Following on from the publicity period for the Plan on the AVDC website, the representations have now been published on that website. An independent examiner has been appointed and the Plan, along with its supporting documents and responses were sent to him on 30th of September. He has now decided that there will be a Hearing. AVDC will identify a suitable local venue and date in conjunction with the Examiner. They will then display a public notice, publish a press notice and of course publicise the Hearing on the Council website, as will your Parish Council.

Taylor Wimpey Planning Application 14/01540/APP (Amended)

The Planning Application for 45 houses on land off Weston Road has been amended with 3 less houses, a relocated attenuation pond on land adjoining the site to the south and a new Locally Equipped Area of Play on the south east side. We have advised AVDC that these changes make no material difference to our grounds for objection. The Application will have to be resubmitted due to procedural formalities and we await the next step before it possibly goes before the AVDC Strategic Development Management Committee. This will potentially be a test case for AVDC to assess in the light of its confliction with our, now mature, draft Neighbourhood Plan.

Cross Parish Proposed Action Concerning AVDC's Policy for Traveller Sites

We have been advised that three parish councils in the Worminghall area of mid Bucks are proposing cross parish action to challenge AVDC on their lack of progress with a coherent policy for Travellers sites and adequate provision thereof. They are concerned about the current ad hoc nature of applications by Travellers for sites in several areas in the absence of alternative provision. Great Horwood Parish Council along with neighbouring Nash Parish Council is also concerned about the "Nash Park" Traveller site between Great Horwood and Nash due to the possibility of an extension beyond the existing Nov 2015 deadline due to lack of alternative provision. We have agreed to support cross parish representation to AVDC but if not timely or forthcoming, that we would take action ourselves. A meeting has also been proposed between AVDC and Nash and Great Horwood Parish Councils to seek progress.

Replacement of Water Main on The Green

Anglian Water have asked for the village green to be deregistered so that they can replace an old water main more easily. The key problem is that The Green is registered as a village green which therefore has protected rights and means that the surface cannot be disturbed. Furthermore, it would entail significant cost and necessitate a replacement area to be nominated. Even if the PC was willing to give permission for these works to be done, it is out of their hands as the ultimate decision is made by the Secretary of State. One alternative would be for a brand new main to be installed under the main road round the perimeter of the Green. This would cause disruption to traffic for a number of weeks but the PC felt it was a better decision than deregistering the village green with all the ensuing ramifications. The Clerk will seek clarification of the legalities of authorising ground works before she responds to Anglian Water

Flooding on The Green

Cllr Mayne has obtained three quotes to deal with the problem of flooding on The Green when heavy rainfall occurs. However, progress with a possible soak away will have to wait until we have gained legal clarification concerning the legality of ground works on The Green.

Defibrillator for the Village

The Village Hall Committee has agreed to the siting of an emergency defibrillator on the front wall of the Village Hall. Cllr Mayne will now contact the Ambulance service to confirm prices and establish the next steps.

Planting of Winter Planters






