

#### **■ GREAT HORWOOD VILLAGE HALL**

Over the last few months I have been telling you about the present day hirers of the hall, this month I want to write an extract from the Village Hall Committee Meeting in April 1924

The Chairman brought forward the matter of the Men's Club at the hall. Among other things not quite in order, dances were being held on a Saturday evening and were kept up till 11pm and in one case, after that. He thought the time ought to be limited. He had spoken to another committee member who thought 7 till 11 pm as the right time.

After a discussion it came out that older members of the club would not attend, probably on account of the behaviour of the younger members, the dance should be called a Dancing Class and as the entry fee 3d to parishioners and 6d to outsiders bought an income to the Men's club, the Men's club should pay 1 shilling per hour hire fee to the Village hall.

The money charged was pre decimal. The rules about the use of the Village hall was much stricter in those days.



He asked that the PC post this information on a community messaging service. Any problems should be reported to TVP on the 101 service so that it can be dealt with there and then. The problem can then be dealt with a Fixed Penalty Notice or the vehicle being recovered at the owner's expense'.

Since this message was put out residents have been making a real effort to leave space for pavement users. The Parish Council would like to send their thanks to those involved.



#### **Great Horwood Pece**

Over the summer we were able to secure a micro grant from AVDC for the landscaping of the play area surrounds. We had decided to soil and grass seed these as the wood surrounds have lasted 10years, but now require weekly repairs. This is stage one of our three stage project of changing the woodchip surface to rubber chippings. Adjustments had to be made due to the grass cutters requiring specific gradients so our thanks to Croudace for gifting extra soil and Tuckwells, who carried out the landscaping, for being so accommodating with our last minute alterations.

Due to the very dry weather we have had, the ground has split in some areas of the field, which seems to have given wild animals starting points to dig for food, please be aware of these when walking!



Chewing to the shelter and the Toddler tunnel is still occurring though not to the degree it had been. Whilst we appreciate we have wild animals capable of this, we also have specific identification of a Hungarian Vizsla causing some damage whilst it's owner/walker seemed oblivious. Please, please respect the equipment and all the hard work that goes into keeping the Rec and it's equipment a pleasant open area for all to enjoy.

Can we also ask the teenagers who like to party on occasion at the Rec, to be mindful of noise and the residents nearby. We have had one of the picnic tables badly broken up which has now been repaired and two consecutive weekends had very noisy goings on into the early hours, culminating in shouting in Spring Lane at 4am. # UNWANTED CALLS ON YOUR BT LANDLINE

Like me, do you get lots of scam calls on your BT landline in spite of having signed up to their call preference service? You may be interested to know how to stop these irritating calls which come at all times of the day by following these very simple instructions yourself. I discovered this easy trick when I phoned 151 a few weeks ago regarding having had no WiFi all day and wary of a recent call I'd received that same day about my BT account having been hacked. I was sure it was a scam call but wanted to check, worried that my bank details might have been hacked.

The very helpful man at BT then told me how to stop all these calls and I've been successfully doing so ever since.

As soon as you receive one of these calls put the receiver down, make sure the call has ended, and then dial 1572, followed, when requested, by Option1. An automated voice will then repeat the most recent number and ask if you want it to be blocked. If so, say yes but if you have changed your mind you can say no.

I have been asked if you can use this service if you don't have a modern phone where the incoming number comes up automatically on your screen. This should still work but you will need to dial 1471 to get the number of the incoming call. When you then dial 1572, option 1, you are only asked about your recent incoming call so your outgoing 1471 call should be irrelevant.
