



# **10 Years of the GH Doctors Car Service**

# The Great Horwood Doctors Car Service took its first customer to the Norden House Surgery on 20th September 2006 and made its 510th return trip on 10th August 2016.

During the research that was carried out in preparation for the publication of the Great Horwood Parish Plan it became clear that one of the problems facing villagers was that there was no available bus service that could provide transport to/from the doctor's surgery in Winslow. So after the publication of the Parish Plan in May 2006 I looked into a way of providing such a service as an alternative to taxis for those who did not have their own transport and who could not be helped by partners, other family members, friends or neighbours.

After recruiting a small number of volunteer drivers we started in September 2006 by advertising a mobile phone number on which anybody requiring to visit the doctors could ring and leave a message. It would then be arranged for one of our volunteer drivers to pick up the villager at their home, take them to the surgery and then wait to bring them home after their appointment. It was agreed that the drivers would receive no reimbursement for the trips and that each user would make whatever contribution that they felt appropriate.

Over the years the surplus funds have been used to provide the bench in the bus shelter at the end of Little Horwood Road and to provide free raffles at the village Pub Lunch Club Christmas Dinners.

Over the 10 years we have transported between 30 and 40 different people, some of whom have made many, many trips and overall we have averaged one trip per week. However, during our busiest year of 2009 we did 99 trips, an average of 2 per week.

Apart from myself, the volunteer drivers who have made the most trips include Jeannie Marshall, David Saunders, Monica Gilbey, Ian Lamberton and Graham Mayger.

We do rely on Focus providing us with a free advert in as many editions as possible so that people who are new to the village can easily find out about our service and give us a call (SEE AD OVERLEAF).

#### Chairman's Monthly Report : Last Meeting – Monday 11 July 2016



The July meeting of the Parish Council considered matters relating to current Great Horwood planning applications and also the Parish Council A 101

A421. Thankfully these all seem to be complete. Thanks were given to the Horwood Pece Management Committee for organising the Picnic on the Pece once again. This is a wellestablished and enjoyable village event now with entertainment provided by the wind band Giocoso. Sadly, there has been some vandalism of picnic tables at the Pece. It's a shame when thoughtlessness interferes with the enjoyment of others in this way.

This all seems a long time ago now. However, the Parish Council has not been idle since then. The MVAS continues to monitor the speed of drivers through entering the village. It is alarming to see how fast some drivers go through the village with no regard to pedestrians and other road users.

Preparation of comments on the consultation on the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan (VALP) has been underway, including in particular a response to the proposal of a possible New Settlement on the Airfield Site. Some of you may have been to a consultation event in Winslow Public Hall which gave a flavour of the complexity of the issues facing Aylesbury Vale District Council and the residents of the area.

By the time you read this the decision of the Secretary of State on the called-in application for development in Weston Road should be known. We have had to wait what seems like a long time since the Inquiry in March but it is only right that the Secretary of State should take the issue of the VALP plans in June into account as well. This has meant that publication of the decision was deferred for a month.

The Parish Council was saddened to learn of the death of Mrs Daphne Hanson. She made a significant contribution to the life of the village in many ways for many years. The Parish Council sends its condolences to her family.






