Police have been investigating

Residents have raised concerns that mail and other items have been stolen from their letter boxes following these visits. Of particular focus has been properties with letter boxes located on external walls or gateways.

Personal details taken through mail box theft can be used for fraudulent activity. It is always advisory to check your accounts or credit sources to ensure all is in order.

Police have the following information for anyone concerned about unsolicited callers attending their property:

- make sure your back door is locked before answering the front door
- use a door chain when opening the door
- ask for identification and check it carefully before letting anyone in
- ask them to come back when someone else is at home with you
- direct people asking for help to a nearby shop or other public place, don't let them in
- · keep all valuables and keys out of sight and out of reach of doors and windows
- don't leave spare keys in obvious places such as under doormats or plant pots
- consider joining or forming a Neighbourhood Watch scheme

In the case of letter box security:

- don't leave keys in mailbox locks
- allow letters to fall through the letter box and avoid collecting them in cages attached to the door.
- if you are away for a number of days, consider asking a neighbour to collect newspapers/letters from your mailbox during your absence.

You can report information to police via the 101 non-emergency telephone number. If you witness a crime in action, always dial 999.



Chairman's Monthly Report: Last Meeting - Monday 10 July 2017



The July meeting of the Parish Council seems a long time ago now. At that meeting the Parish Council Great Horwood dealt with usual items about Parish Council roadworks, footpaths and Horwode Pece. The lack of signed alternative

routes during the overnight road closures of the A413 in Winslow was noted. Arrangements were made for the planters around the village to be watered, little realising the amount of rain that would fall in the following month.

Planning issues were discussed and concern was expressed about the continuing delays and difficulties that we are experiencing with the planning system at AVDC. This concern appears to be shared by many parishes in the Vale. The revised timetable for the Aylesbury Vale Local Plan was noted. The Plan would be considered by AVDC in the autumn before public comments are sought.

The Parish Council also considered the terms of the proposed new lease to the Cricket Club of the Recreation Field and it is hoped that this will be finalised fairly soon.

The Parish Council does not have a formal meeting in August although the work of the Council continues.

Vandalism of one of the planters and damage to a table at Horwode Pece have all meant additional work. This anti-social behaviour is very discouraging to all who make such vital contributions to keeping our community attractive.

Arrangements for maintenance of hedges have continued and Speedwatch activities will shortly be resuming.




