Minutes of an Ordinary Parish Council held on  $9^{th}$  April 2018 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall, Great Horwood.

1.	To receive apologies for absence Apologies were received from Cllr Heywood and Dist Cllr Stanier.
2.	To receive declarations of interest  ● None.
3.	Confirmation of the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 12 <sup>th</sup> March 2018  • The Minutes were passed without amendment.
4.	To consider matters arising from the Minutes of the last meeting (not otherwise included in the agenda)  • None.
5.	To review and confirm the Register of Interest for Councillors This could not be completed as two disclosure forms are still awaited.
6.	<ul> <li>Public Participation</li> <li>Cllr MS thanked County Cllr John Chilver for his help in expediting the repair of the footpath bridges discussed in item 8b.</li> </ul>
7.	Horwode Pece Management Committee Report  The Horwode Pece Management Committee report is attached to, and forms part of, these Minutes.
8.	Footpath Report  a). To receive the Footpath Report.  Mr Robert Deuchar is making provisional inquiries about a location for another metal footpath gate. On FP 5, location B, (GR: 75653203) the landowner has removed half of one of the two adjacent stiles making them easy to walk around. Mr Deuchar plans an inspection of the Parish's footpaths before the next PC meeting.  b). To consider progress with the footpath bridges reported to Bucks County Council (BCC).  The Rights of Way Officer has inspected the bridge on FP7 at the junction with FP5 and will arrange for it to be repaired. The team has been asked to remedy the awkward access to the deck. A work order has also raised to install a handrail on the bridge just off Pilch Lane on FP4.  Cllr MS offered a vote of thanks to Mr Deuchar for his hard work monitoring and trimming the footpath network.
9.	Roads Report  a). Potholes have been mended on Spring Lane and Little Horwood Road and some on the High St.  The problem with water running down Singleborough Lane has been rectified.  b). There was nothing to report on the MVAS or speed watch and the protocol for use and loan of the Sentinel equipment was postponed to the next meeting.  c). The report on the Spring Lane road junction survey is not yet available as more statistical work is required.  The Clerk was asked to contact Bucks CC to complain about the traffic control measures that have appeared twice on Winslow Road without notice in the last two weeks. (Action Clerk)
10.	Parish Maintenance a). Progress with replacing the bench on the village green. Councillors reviewed the document and catalogues sent to them. They decided to explore the possibility of replacing the wooden bench on The Green with a bench made from recycled materials. The Clerk will ask how vandal and cigarette resistant this type of bench is and whether a commemorative plaque can be placed on it. (Action Clerk) b). To consider placing an extra bollard on The Green to protect the new tree. It was decided to place bollards on the corner of The Green where traffic is churning up the newly trimmed verge. ABH Landscapes would be asked to undertake the work and to match the bollards already in place near the telephone box. The Clerk also reported that  • the footpath sign adjacent to the cricket club has been repaired. • Bucks CC has been approached for permission to place a disabled ramp on the pavement outside the village hall. • a new general information board is required adjacent to the Parish Council board. It was decided to look for a model with doors.
11.	To consider devolution responsibilities  a). Walker Grounds Care was confirmed as the devolution contractor for 2018/2019.
12.	To consider the Parish Priorities list  To consider the Parish Priorities list  To consider the Parish Priorities list was approved following a discussion on the provision of a MUGA. It was noted that the Village Hall committee would be submitting an application for a New Homes Bonus grant for structural improvements to the hall.
13.	To review and confirm the Register of Interest for Councillors  • Already considered at item 5 above.
14.	Planning Report  The planning report was ratified.
15.	Issues arising from the Planning Report  Clir MS gave a brief report on the machine with the developers of 17/01/1/2/APP land ediscent to 2 Little Henried Read. It was felt that this was

	a positive development with the developers open to increasing the number of houses to 3 or 4 although issues with parking and protected trees are complicating planning of the site.						
16.	Other planning matters  a). Mr David Saunders advised that the new National Planning Policy Framework was proposing to change how housing need was distributed around the country. If implemented, Aylesbury Vale could be compelled to increase its housing requirement by 20 – 30%. It is, therefore conceivable that the (as yet unimplemented) Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan and the Great Horwood Neighbourhood Plan would require revision to take such changes into account.  b). Councillors considered a proposal that Winslow & Great Horwood could work together on their respective Neighbourhood Plans. Councillors resolved to make an informal approach to Winslow Town Council to ascertain their views on the idea.						
17.	To consider Resilience Planning for the Parish Clir AM gave a brief outline of the Wi's involvement with the Bucks County Council and Milton Keynes emergency planning unit. It was resolved to:  place a link to the Buckinghamshire Community Planning guidance on the Parish website. (Action Clerk)  to draft a notice asking residents to volunteer to be included in a list of emergency helpers. (Action JRH)

## Horwode Pece Management Committee - Report to Parish Council April 2018

This month we held the first of the two 'Spring working parties', over the weekend of 17th-18th March. Items planned to be repaired included: the log-surrounds, both for the toddler and teenage areas, the goal nets and some minor repairs to other equipment. However, weather was against us – it was snowing quite heavily and this continued all weekend. In this inclement weather we managed to repair the toddler log surround, but not complete the other tasks planned. These will now role over to the 'Late-Spring' working party, planned for 12th-13th May.

As originally planned, the 'Late-Spring' working party was to install the three picnic tables, purchased late autumn. We will now aim to complete any outstanding maintenance work to the play equipment at the same time. To help, Steve Brigden agreed to take the 3 picnic table flat-packs and assemble them at his workshop, ready for installation on the 12th-13th May, so freeing up time for the additional maintenance work.

In the most recent Rec. check reports, it has been noted how wet the Rec. gets particularly in between the toddler and teenage play areas, also in the middle of the football ground and in areas around the zip wire. Thus, if sufficient helpers arrive, we will also aim to address these drainage issues. This may mean digging a bigger soak-away to store any surface water, before it drains into the adjacent stream.

One last item for the diary, 'Picnic on the Pece' will be held on the 10th June. 'Giocoso' has agreed to play for us again this year. Please, let everyone know through the Parish web-site.
