LOCAL GREEN SPACE

Neighbourhood plans may designate small tracts of land as Local Green Space, in order to safeguard green areas of particular value to the local community.

The land must be in close proximity to the community. It must also be demonstrably special, and hold a particular local significance. The significance might, for example, involve landscape beauty, historical importance, or recreational value.

We are considering designating the following small tracts of land as Local Green Space:



- 1 Shorts Field
- 2 Church Lane allotments
- 3 Liden Park
- 4 Willow Road allotments
- 5 Horwode Pece

The Village Green and the Cricket Field are registered Village Greens and are afforded protection as a result of that.

There are also other tracts of land in the Parish which are protected from development in other ways.
