We have one point of feedback in relation to paragraph 3.3. We suggest revising the wording as set out below, as the figure already provided was a formal indicative figure in accordance with paragraph 70 of the NPPF:

"The process of drafting the Plan and assessing the sites will be informed by the Parish Council's judgement on the number of new homes to allocate. It is not expected that the LPA will provide a housing requirement figure beyond the indicative housing figure already provided, and will only be in a position to provide the housing requirement figure from the regulation 19 version of the LP4B onwards."
