24/161 Welcome and Apologies for Absence. The Chairman welcomed everyone, apologies for absence received and accepted from District Cllr Peter Schwier (due to work commitments).

24/162 Declaration of Interests.

24/163 Public Participation Session with respect to items on the agenda and other matters that are of mutual interest.

Various members of the public spoke regarding speeding along Braintree Road to High Garrett and through the village. Very difficult to cross the road and to stand and wait for a bus. Hardstanding area is uneven and vegetation overgrown. Traffic has increased which has an impact on the whole village. Infrastructure requires to be improved urgently. An allotment tenant asked if the Parish Council could apply to the Rowson Perpetual Memorial fund to ask for funding

to put towards chicken manure for the plots.

Cllr Strudwick although making a declaration of interest at item 24/162 spoke on item 24/166 Ref: 24/01631/HH (The Clerk advised that he should not and so did the Chairman) but he continued anyway to explain the history and position of the public rights of way in the area.

24/164 County and District Councillors to address the members if present.

County Councillor Cllr Chris Siddall addressed the publics concerns to the speeding traffic. Various options have been considered but do not meet the criteria set out by Essex County Council Highways. Essex County Council are looking at all speed limits in the area and he is actively trying to get the speed limits reduced and for Halstead, Earls Colne and Gosfield to have extra white lines painted on the roads which would help. This is an ongoing issue, the Local Highway Panel (LHP) hold 4 meetings a year and members of the public can attend, if members of the public wish to do so they will need to contact Cllr Siddall direct.

Previous minute No. 24/129 Open Space land at the top of Meadway – update still awaiting information regarding the knee-high fencing access gate from BDC and Public Rights of Way have concerns relating to the public footpath number 11 and are in discussion with the developer. Parish Council to contact the developer as trees need to be replaced as they have died.

A meeting was held with BDC and we have now received confirmation that the S106 funding can be spent on the uneven grass paths around the plots. The original questionnaires/survey relating to housing needs, it was confirmed by Cllr Willis that the housing needs of the village have now been met with the new developments at the top of Meadway and The Limes. To move forward to the next stage and to send the amended plan to BDC and go out to public consultation.
