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### 24/029 Playing Field Management Committee.

Previous Minute No. 21/118 To consider and approve the revised agreement. A draft agreement was distributed to all Councillors and the Chairman of the Playing Field Management Committee to be considered and on the next agenda.

### 23/030 Skate Ramp.

Previous minute No. 23/280 Position of Skate Ramp – to discuss and agree the position of a possible new skate ramp. It was agreed that the new position should be near the zip wire along the left-hand side of the football pitch away from the goal areas.

### 24/031 Gosfield In Bloom.

Gosfield In Bloom would like to move the green planters (2) from the entrance to the park to outside the shop. Nothing grows in them under the shade of the oak trees. They would be re-sited between the yellow bollards on the concrete apron in line with Barry Deals crown. Permission was granted for the green planters to be removed and relocated but something would need to replace them in the current location, to try and avoid parking on the grass area.

### 24/032 Wire netting.

To consider wire netting at the far entrance along Church Road onto the playing field, as leaves blowing into residents' properties. It was unanimously agreed that no wire netting should be put in place as it would not resolve the issue as leaves blow everywhere.

### 24/033 Neighbourhood Plan.

Neighbourhood Plan Committee meeting had taken place Cllr John Willis (Chairman) confirmed that more evidence is required to address individual categories so a new short survey required to be completed by residents as the plan will need to contain the same policies as the BDC local plan. The funding money needs to be spent by April.

### 23/034 Wethersfield Asylum centre.

To discuss the Home Office is seeking a Special Development Order for Wethersfield, three years permission for the asylum centre. Cllr Strudwick gave an update on this item. Environmental impact assessments required from the Ministry of Defence. The prison application has gone to the appeal committee. Wethersfield Scrutiny Committee is ongoing and updates in the press.
