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Item 8. Neighbourhood Plan – Consultation is now closed and information has been sent to the consultant, awaiting recommendation to come back him, Cllr Willis updated on the new grant funding application.

Car Park – Cllr Willis confirmed that the National Lottery had declined the funding application and to now try to obtain funding from other sources it was agreed that all funding needs to be in place before works can commence. The Parish Council agreed to make an application for financial assistance for £60,00.00 from the Rowson Trust.

Application for funding submitted to Sport England and they have awarded a grant for £7,500.00 subject to conditions, the Parish Council will have to go out to Crowd fund and match the funding. The Parish Council decided they would accept the conditions of the awarded funding and go out to crowd fund and raise further money for the project.
