25/038 Welcome and Apologies for Absence. The Chairman welcomed everyone, apologies for absence received and accepted from Cllr Tony Farrelly (due to holiday) and District Cllr P. Schwier (due to illness).

25/040 Public Participation Session with respect to items on the agenda and other matters that are of mutual interest.

A member of the public updated the Parish Council that the footbridge (worst one) in the nature reserve has been repaired Parish Council to consider repairs to the other two (item to be on the next agenda). Serious damage to ferns etc has happened due to the muntjack to explore options of deterrent. The 5-year management plan is in progress and an item asking for resident's views will be in the Grapevine.

A member of the public asked about the speed surveys carried in Gosfield Road, accident information etc has been provided and given to Cllr Siddall

25/041 County and District Councillors to address the members if present.

County Councillor Chris Siddall – gave an update on the speed surveys carried out in Gosfield Road, the majority are well within the 60mph limit and consistent throughout the day. When on site traffic calming was discussed (carriage way signage) however the design engineer at Highways has said that this is not possible in that area. Highways Liaison Officer has said that this area is not a village/hamlet as not enough houses in the area to meet the criteria. Collision data etc has been taken into consideration and the proposed scheme (40mph) does not meet the criteria which must be evidence based and Highways will not go against policy. Clir Siddall to follow up this decision with Tom Cunningham and speed data to be shared. Zebra crossing speed survey results also requested to be shared.

Devolution reform now together and agreed an outline plan. further meetings at Essex County Council will take place. LHP (Local Highway Panel) is being suspended as Essex County Council looking at how it will go forward in the future.

Item 6. Car Park – It was confirmed that an application for financial assistance of £60,000.00 has been made to the Rowson Perpetual Memorial Fund, await decision, also awaiting a decision from BDC regarding the S106 funding. All funding needs to be in place before works can commence.

Item 7. Skate Ramp previous minute 24/279 – To confirm that the acceptance documents have been returned to Sport England. The Crowdfunder website is currently work in progressing. Clerk has contacted suppliers to confirm a site meeting, still awaiting a date and photos for the website.

Item 11. Fairy Trail in Gosfield Nature Reserve, update by Cllr Strudwick that this is progressing hopefully to be open end April/early May. Cllr Siddall invited to open the fairy trail exact grand opening date to be advised at the next meeting, item to be on the next agenda.

Item 12. Previous minute No. 24/146 The Beacon – new one is currently being built and should be finished in April ready for VE Day event.

Item 13. VE Day Event 8th May 2025 – update work is progressing and events planned, tickets are available to purchase in the community shop. Party in the park, BBQ on the playing field, grants received for this, VE Day flag purchased for the Church and the new beacon will be lit.

Item 14. Allotments, Clerk has sent out e-mails to plot holders to tidy up the plots. Plots 3a and 3b have been rented out to a new tenant. The poly tunnel dimensions and shelving needs to be confirmed before purchase, item to be on the next agenda.
