25/216 Welcome and Apologies for Absence. The Chairman welcomed everyone, apologies for absence received and accepted from Cllr Waters (Vice-Chairman) (Due to holiday).

#### 25/217 Declaration of Interests.

# 25/218 Public Participation Session with respect to items on the agenda and other matters that are of mutual interest.

A member of the public expressed her opinion that she did not like the yellow paint on the skate ramp and would like to know if the cost figures will be broken down and published. The Chairman replied that the colour was chosen on recommendation of the contractor and for safety reasons it needs to be bright, breakdown of costs of the skate ramp will be published in the Grapevine magazine, and it was confirmed that the skate ramp was installed with funded money by grants.

A member of the public said that she did not like the fairies in the nature reserve made of plastic, Cllr Strudwick explained that they were made of resin and responded that the idea for the fairy trail was to encourage young and old (everyone) to engage and enjoy nature, volunteers are always welcome for additional input and views the item will be in the next edition of the Grapevine to try and set up a working group of volunteers, called friends of Gosfield Nature Reserve.

# 25/219 County and District Councillors to address the members if present.

County Cllr Siddall praised the initiative of Gosfield Parish Council on implementing the Fairy Trail, he has funding available for biodiversity works in the Nature Reserve see item 25/232. Parking in Halstead High Street may change in the new year and a ticket machine may be installed at the top of the town this is an ongoing discussion and a decision to charge for parking will be made in January. The pavements at the bottom of Halstead high street are being investigated re possible repairs which he is trying to get resolved. Speeding on rural roads was discussed and he confirmed that most speed surveys (99%) come back within specification and meet the guidelines for Highways.

District Cllr Schwier continues to send regular updates to the Parish Council. He is also against car park charges in Halstead along with Cllr Siddall. BDC are currently looking to set their budget with scrutiny on expenditure. Wethersfield numbers have increased and BDC are engaging with the Home Office, he also has community grant money/funding available for biodiversity in the nature reserve, see item 25/232.

Alleged Breach: Appeal against the unauthorised material change of use of the land for the siting of containers for storage purposes and the construction of an earth bund along the Eastern boundary.

# Enforcement Case 20/00117/UBW3: Planning ref: 20/00915/FUL Oaklands Shardlowes Farm.

Update by BDC 17 August 2025. The planning history at this location shows that an enforcement investigation was raised in March 2020 under reference 20/00117/UBW3 in order to investigate a building which had been constructed without the benefit of planning consent. A planning application was subsequently received and refused and an appeal to the planning inspectorate followed, this was dismissed favouring the Council's position. The enforcement history indicates that formal enforcement action was not supported by the Planning Development Manager in this instance, therefore the building has become time barred from enforcement action under section 171b Town & Country Planning Act 1990 rendering it lawful, the enforcement investigation was closed accordingly.

#### Ref: 25/02457/TPO

Description: Notice of intent to carry out works to trees protected by Tree Preservation Order 23/82:

Approx. 12 - 15 coppice stools of Willow (Salix caprea) growing on the banks of the Horseshoe Pond. Coppice. The trees are fallen, partially fallen or likely to fall, and all are excluding light from the pond. Felling will produce new growth, ensure bank stability, and improve light to the pond, thereby improving the wetland habitat.

R/o 72 Edmund Green. Oak (Quercus robur). Reduce growth over garden back to boundary and/ or stable growth points, to maintain light levels/reduce shading over small rear garden.

R/o 3 De Vere Close. Oak (Quercus robur). Reduce two overextended lateral boughs above the rear garden of No. 2 De Vere Close by approximately 3m cutting back to suitable growth points, to improve stability and reduce shading. Ash (Fraxinus excelsior). Fell. The tree has early signs of Ash Dieback, with large quantities of small dead wood, and limited epicormic shoots. Nearby smaller specimens have died and fallen/been felled, but this tree will rapidly become a danger to path users and adjacent property. No replanting proposed, given the existing tree cover.

This will provide 2.5m of clearance. 1 lower branch towards the garden to balance the crown. Oak (T2) to reduce the large elongating limb over the lawn by 1.5m
