## **Uttlesford District Council**

### **Local Plan update**

The main modifications consultation to the Local Plan closed on 27 October. This was the final consultation on proposed changes to the Local Plan as recommended by the Planning Inspectors. UDC had around 80 responses from developers, parish councils, residents and others, and they have been sent to the Inspectors and will also be published on our website on 14 November.

We must now wait for the Inspectors to review them and only the Inspectors can now make any final changes to the Local Plan. The Inspectors will then write to UDC with a detailed report to advise on the final modifications that must be made and whether, or not they consider the Local Plan fit for adoption. This process usually takes 4 to 6 weeks and so we should know the outcome towards the end of the year.
