Councillors to consider revised Draft Local Plan - Regulation 19

A revised and improved Draft Uttlesford Local Plan is expected to bring high quality homes, employment and infrastructure to the district and will be considered by councillors at full council on 30th July, you can watch this debate by going to the UDC website and following the link.

The council continues to prepare for at least 14,741 homes that are required between 2021 and 2041. Around 8,700 of these have already been built or have planning permission. The level of housing allocations for 6,076 homes that was initially proposed in Regulation 18, has been reduced to 4,638 homes to be built over the next seventeen years.

Owing the last local plan being more than 19 years old it is crucial that a new plan is put into place to stop the speculative applications at unsuitable locations. Councils that have a current Local Plan have greater powers to approve or reject unsuitable individual planning applications compared to

those that don't have one in place, and it is vital that Uttlesford's Local Plan is approved so that we can once again take back development control locally. Don't forget, if accepted by council, the plan consultation will take place from 8th August until 3rd of October, this is an eight week period instead of the regulatory six weeks and details of locations where you can see and ask questions will be published on the UDC website.

General Election

As you are no doubt aware from the press there was an issue with 2,688 North West Essex postal votes being delivered late in the Chelmsford area of the constituency. This did not affect our ward (now in Harlow), but in the spirit of transparency the Leader of the Council, Councillor Petrina Lees has called in an outside body to investigate the issue with the full report to be published on the Uttlesford website when completed.

77% of these postal votes were returned on time which is within the usual parameters of expectancy across the country. The 2,610 majority for Ms Badenoch could therefore not have been overturned by this delay.
