

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary Election for the Harlow constituency

1. An Election is to be held of One Member of Parliament for Harlow.
2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained from the Elections Office, Latton Bush Centre, Southern Way, Harlow, Essex, CM18 7BL.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Latton Bush Centre, Southern Way, Harlow, Essex, CM18 7BL on any day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than 4 pm on Friday 7 June 2024. An appointment should be made in advance by phoning Alison on 01279 446038 or emailing alison.hodgson@harlow.gov.uk
4. The required £500 deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or, with the Acting Returning Officer's consent, in any other manner (including by debit or credit card or the electronic transfer of funds).
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 18 June 2024. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday 19 June.
8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Latton Bush Centre, Southern Way, Harlow, Essex, CM18 7BL by 5 pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Thursday 4 July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024.
