We are now proud to say, thanks to the work of the Parish Council, that our village now have a lifesaving defribiliator available for use in an emergency, it is located on the car park side of The Great Braxted Pavilion building. (see pictures).

Should you be in the unfortunate position to have to use this, you would dial 999 from your mobile, and the operative should be able to provide the access code and instructions for use.

Further to this all defibrillators are registered with the emergency services, so can advise on your nearest available defibrillator at anytime.





Trucam speed checks come to Great Braxted

Some of you may have noticed Maldon Council Community protection officers, operating speed checks in Great Braxted recently.

This is an initiative paid for by The Parish Council on a six month rolling contract, in response to our villagers concerns around the danger of speeding vehicles through the village.

The officers will operate at least twice a month, at different times of the day, optimised to deter persistent offenders, the first month saw two offenders captured and referred to the appropriate authorities for legal processes to take their course.

If you FIND a dog ...

- Look around the area and see if there is anyone obviously looking for their lost pet.
- Report to the local council (dog warden); it is the law and they may already have had the
 dog reported as missing. You can find details of your local dog warden on-line here:
 www.gov.uk/report-stray-dog
- If you can, take the dog to a local vets for them to scan for a chip.
 In most cases they will then be able to call the owner if dog is chipped, or call the local dog warden to collect if not.
- In Scotland you should also report to the police.
- Also check in the 'Lost' section of the DogLost website to see if this dog has been reported as missing. www.doglost.co.uk/dog-search.php?status=Lost
- Many of our volunteers in the area do have scanners so may be able to come out and scan the dog for you. You can ask on local DogLost pages if anyone can help or call our head office for more information.
- Register the dog on the DogLost website: www.doglost.co.uk
 and share on Social Media such as Facebook / Twitter, local DogLost pages and groups.
- You can also print posters from this dog's page using the View Poster button and put up around the area that he / she was found. Don't forget to laminate in case it rains.
- If you can, put Posters in local shops, pubs, garages, supermarkets; everywhere that there
 are a lot of people. Spread the word to try to find the owners...
