Current Playground Removal

Not without its challenges, the current playground equipment has all been successfully removed.

The whole area where equipment has been removed along with the entry gate on Bung Row have been roped off for health & safety purposes.



Playground & Cricket Field - Tree/Hedge Cutting

As advised in the October update the Great Braxted Parish Council & Pavilion Management Committee are funding the tree/hedge cutting of both the internal & external Playground & Cricket Field.



Walton Tree Services are engaged to undertake the job. The first stage was the internal playground field which took place on Monday 25th October 2021.



The next staged dates are proposed as:

- 1 Day – 19th Nov 2021
- 3 days – 1-3rd Dec 2021
- 2 days – 9-10th Dec 2021



Playground Installation – Key Dates

- Start date is currently set for **Monday 15th November 2021** (weather dependent)
 - Hours of operation are Mon-Fri 8.00am-17.30pm / Saturday 8.00am-13.00pm
- Anticipated time on site – **4 weeks** (possibly 5 weeks depending on weather conditions)
- Anticipated completion date – **Friday 10th December / Friday 17th December** (weather dependent)
 - The new playground however will not be open for public usage until we have had the post installation inspection (& certificate) by an independent 3rd party.
 - 'The Play Inspection Company' (www.playinspections.co.uk) have been engaged to undertake the job and the subsequent 2 years annual inspections.
