If you do bag the dog poo, please either place it in a dog bin or take it home with you. If you decide to throw the bag into a hedge, you are committing 2 offences, one of littering and one of dog fouling. Please act responsibly for everyone's consideration and health.

As well as dog fouling there is no excuse for littering. Many of the road verges show the antisocial behaviour of drivers. If you see any litter that has been left that can be identified back to the person who left it, please take a picture of it, and send it to either myself or report via maldon.gov.uk. if you can provide the date, place and time that you found it. The community officers can then investigate and fine the individuals.
