Queen's Baton Relay Commonwealth Games 2022 – Ufest - 8th July

An exciting day of events is being planned, running from 11am to 8pm, with activities, stalls and events for the whole community, focusing on health, wellbeing and fun. There will be live music, street food from around the world and a fantastic selection of games, sports and activities to take part in throughout the day.

And, of course, the highlight will be watching the 10 official Baton bearers carrying the Queen's Baton, with its message for the Commonwealth, around the lake and out to the statue of Byrhtnoth.

The district has now been placed into tier one for levelling up funds by the government. This means that over the next 3 years the district will be able to access funding to improve infrastructure, culture, heritage and business. I will be trying to influence how some of this money can improve public transport in the rural areas of the ward.

The council has gained funding to commission and design new entrance signs to the district. I was involved the project and I believe that the designs that have been produced will prove to be iconic and create a great impression to anyone arriving in the district.


