Maldon District Councillor News

I am pleased to let residents know, that highway's applications are progressing. The process is slow, hampered by limited resources at Essex County Council. Improvements should be seen in the coming year in, Little Totham with new village gateway signs and at the verge sides. Changes at the Five Corners junction to reduce speeding and at the school, and in Totham north.

There are other applications in process and I will keep residents informed. If you do have any suggestion for highway or pavement improvements, then please let me know. The funding for the district has been increased, so we therefore need to ensure that money is used.

The council is looking at the long-term future of the council offices and site. It was agreed to conduct a feasibility study into the current offices. It will investigate whether it is better to stay in the current location or reutilise the site and move to a new location. Any proposals will need to be feasible and cost effective.

I have also been involved in the corporate planning for the council and ensuring the that the finances of the council are secure. At the same time, we need deliver services to residents in an effective and efficient manner. This also may mean that we share services with other authorities.

At the last Great Braxted parish council meeting, there was a lot of concern about the options that had come forward in the Local development plan review. It is important to remember that at this stage they are just options, and the consultation process is about listening to the views of the residents. There will be lots of further consultation as the plan moves forward, and I will ensure that the village is kept updated and informed.




