News from District Councillor

Due to the driver shortage and fuel crisis our waste contractor Suez, as you know has had difficulty providing a good service over the past months. We have been working with them to give them support, whilst still holding them to account. It has not been an ideal situation, however we have been delivering a higher level of service that other district councils in Essex.

I have been applying for further highway applications across the ward. I am hoping that in roads that are purely residential, that measures can be introduced that will limit the speed of vehicles. If you know of a highway improvement that you would like to see happen, then please get in touch.

The other funding that is available is for visual street improvements and for improvement to pavements. As a resident you will know more than me where this needs to happen. If you live on a road where there are lots of uneven pavements or it needs visual improvements, there is funding available for this type of work. Please let me know and I can then take any improvements forward




As this is a chargeable service, and to ensure that customers receive the same number of collections for the service, the current subscription year will be extended to mid-May 2022.
