GREAT WALTAM PARISH COUNCIL TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE EMERGENCY COMMITTEE

- 1. The emergency committee is primarily constituted to create and monitor an emergency plan to support the Parish.
- 2. The committee will comprise a minimum of 7 members of the full Parish Council.
 - a. One member will be the Parish Council Chair.
 - b. The second member will be the Parish Council Vice Chair.
 - c. Up to 3 members will be appointed to the Committee at the Annual General meeting of the Parish Council (or at the next meeting if members join by co-option). Membership to be drawn from across the Parish.
- 3. The First Order of business when the committee convenes after an annual general meeting will be to elect a chairperson of the Committee
- 4. The committee meets 1 time a year in July.
- 5. The sub-committee will not have any finances allocated to them.
- 6. Items to be discussed at the committee meeting must be on the Agenda.
- 7. The Agenda will be published in advance of the meeting (Minimum 3 clear days) and e-mailed to members and displayed on noticeboards.
- 8. Minutes of the committee shall be distributed promptly.
- 9. The Clerk will act as secretary.
