- 5. Update from the Speedwatch representatives from Ford End and Great Waltham.
  - Ford End.
    - The previous coordinator, sadly passed away in August 2023. The Council acknowledges and appreciates the work she did for the parish in association with the village Speedwatch team.
    - $\circ$  Team of 7 go out once a week. Five local residents.
    - Recruitment drive on Parish News and Facebook.
    - School layby is an ideal position.
    - Catch 5-15 drivers speeding in the hour of monitoring.
    - Speeds between 36-53 mph in the sessions.
    - Two serious accidents since August 2023. A barrier was hit by a pickup truck on the wrong side of the road (early hours). Then, a car in the ditch beyond the school.
    - 2022 the School wall was knocked down while classes were in session.
    - Can some coordination between the SID movements and the Speedwatch teams be created?
    - Speedwatch can be a two-person team as long as they have a mobile phone. Three people is preferred.
  - Great Waltham.
    - o School holidays restricts the deployment of the team.
    - Five members.
    - Additional site at Church End towards the cricket ground investigated. 100m sight line either way required. Request has been sent in for approval.
    - A new camera made available and will be issued to the team.
    - Another advert to be run in the Parish News for volunteers.
    - Usually get between 30-40 drivers exceeding the speed limit in the one-hour session.
    - New Police reporting form (Version 10) is currently being used.
    - Three warning letters from the Police in response to Speedwatch reporting can then escalate to request to attend speed awareness course.
