The Essex County Council (B1008 Sandon Hill, Ford End, Great Waltham) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*

The Essex County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(1) & (2)(a), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. That length of road as specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a Derestricted road for the purposes of Sections 82(1) & (2)(a), 83(2) of the Act.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of the B1008 Sandon Hill, in the village of Ford End, in the Parish of Great Waltham, in the City of Chelmsford, as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 5. This order shall come into operation on and may be cited as The Essex County Council (B1008 Sandon Hill, Ford End, Great Waltham) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*.
