

Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council held on Monday 19th May 1980, at the Hulton Hall, Great Waltham.

(d) Village Signs (2d) - The Chairman reported that the letter from the Borough Council together with the design had been discussed with the Twinning Association and they were agreeable that such signs be sited at the entrances to Great Waltham village on the A 130 reading 'Great Waltham twinned with Ceyrat'. The clerk reported that a further letter from the Borough Council stated that the cost of each sign would be approximately £90 and that the whole of the cost would have to be met by the Parish Council. It was agreed that the matter be considered along with agenda item 25 concerning a decorative village sign.

Minutes of the monthly meeting of the Parish Council held on Monday 21st July 1980, at the Hulton Hall, Great Waltham.

(d) Great Waltham Parish Jubilee Twinning Association - Village Sign (11c)
The clerk reported that the wording of the sign had been agreed between the Parish Council and the Twinning Association. A few problems had occurred over the Essex County Councils policy on wording of village signs but these had been overcome. A design problem regarding the use of the word 'France' on the sign had now occurred. To include the word on the sign would increase the overall cost by £20. The Council referred the matter to the Twinning Association as they were meeting the cost of the sign, with the comment that the Council were not concerned at the word 'France' not being included. A letter from the Twinning Association regarding the meaning of the elements of the Ceyrat coat-of-arms was 'laid on the table'.

3. Matters arising from the minutes.

(a) Great Waltham Parish Jubilee Twinning Association - Village Sign (3a). -the clerk reported that the sign was ready for erection, The unveiling would take place on Saturday 25th October 1980 by Mr David Curry, our European Member of Parliament, followed by a reception in the school hall. The question of the insurance of the sign, once installed was discussed. It was agreed that this be placed on the Parish Councils insurance if no other insurance cover was provided by the Highway Authority. Further investigations would be made.
