It's All Greek to Me (cont)

The last figure of well-known Greek literature was the Athenian orator Demosthenes who lived in the mid-4th century BC. This was the time when Philip of Macedon, father of Alexander the great, was extending his power in north Greece, by a step by step approach of picking off individual cities. Demosthenes could see through the devious diplomacy of Philip, to his true intention of total subjugation of Greece, and spoke out against it in the Athenian assembly. His speeches have survived, and were called by a name which has lasted into English, perhaps somewhat old fashioned now, a "Phillipic", a speech of denunciation. A previous generation compared the Churchill of the 1930s to Demosthenes, a foreteller of coming doom ignored by his contemporaries. However in the Greek world of course, the outcome was very different. Philip succeeded in subduing the whole of Greece before he was murdered, and his son Alexander further extended that power to most of the then known world. Meanwhile, poor Demosthenes, although he lived to see the end of Alexander, himself ended up by committing suicide, a fugitive from his own city.






