- 06/2025/0244: Proposal; Permission in Principle for up to 6 dwellings. Land adjacent South Lodge, Haighton Green Lane. This is a similar application to that submitted in December 2021 for 4 self-build dwellings. HPC's response was unchanged- the application was purely speculative and failed to satisfy any of the criteria for Policy EN1 Open Countryside.
- 06/2025/[0254: Proposal: Permission in Principle for up to 6 dwellings. Simpson House Farm, Fernyhalgh Lane. This was a further application following the approval by PCC to convert 3 barns to 3 dwellings. HPC objected to the new application, stating that it appeared to be an attempt to circumvent the planning system which would probably have refused an application for 6 dwellings following the demolition of all the farm buildings if submitted initially.
- 06/2024/0424: Proposal to reduce the width of the public footpath at Sumners Farm, Cow Hill; still no decision.
