NEW AFFORDABLE HOUSING SCHEDULED FOR COMPLETION IN FEBRUARY 2022 MAKE SURE YOU HAVE EXPRESSED AN INTEREST



Being built by Hastoe Housing Association adjacent to Boreham Court are four new affordable homes for people with a local connection to High Easter. There will be 1x3 bedroom and 3x2 bedroom homes for rental.

If you are interested in being considered for one of these properties it is essential you are on the Uttlesford housing register, see Uttlesford website or this link which will take you to the registration form, https://www.uttlesford.gov.uk/article/5308/I-want-to-apply-for-a-Council-or-Housing-Association-Home

Uttlesford is responsible for providing the Housing Association with nominations for tenancy and the Uttlesford website will explain how the process works. Please note if there is no difference between individuals in terms of eligibility it will come down to how long you have been on the housing register, so it's important to apply as soon as possible.

These properties have a local eligibility criteria which are set out in the s106 agreement and remain with the scheme throughout. They are,

- 1. Been permanently resident in High Easter for at least 2 years.
- 2. No longer resident in High Easter bus has been so resident for at least 3 years during the past 5 years.
- 3. Is either in permanent employment in High Easter and has been for a minimum of 2 years and is working for a minimum of 24 hours per week or having close relatives, (i.e., parents, grandparents, children, siblings); living in High Easter who have livered there for at least 5 years.

If there was insufficient interest from the parish, those from the nominated adjoining Uttlesford parishes have an opportunity to be considered before the net widens to anyone in Uttlesford.
