This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

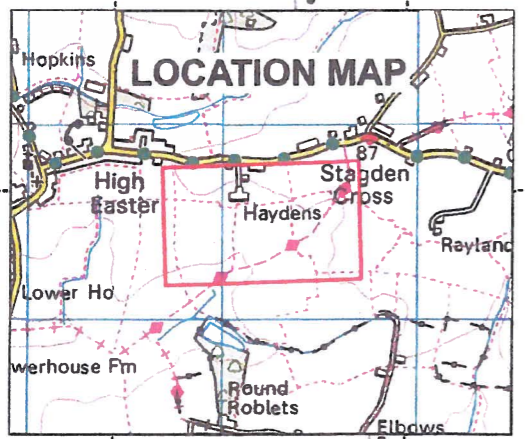
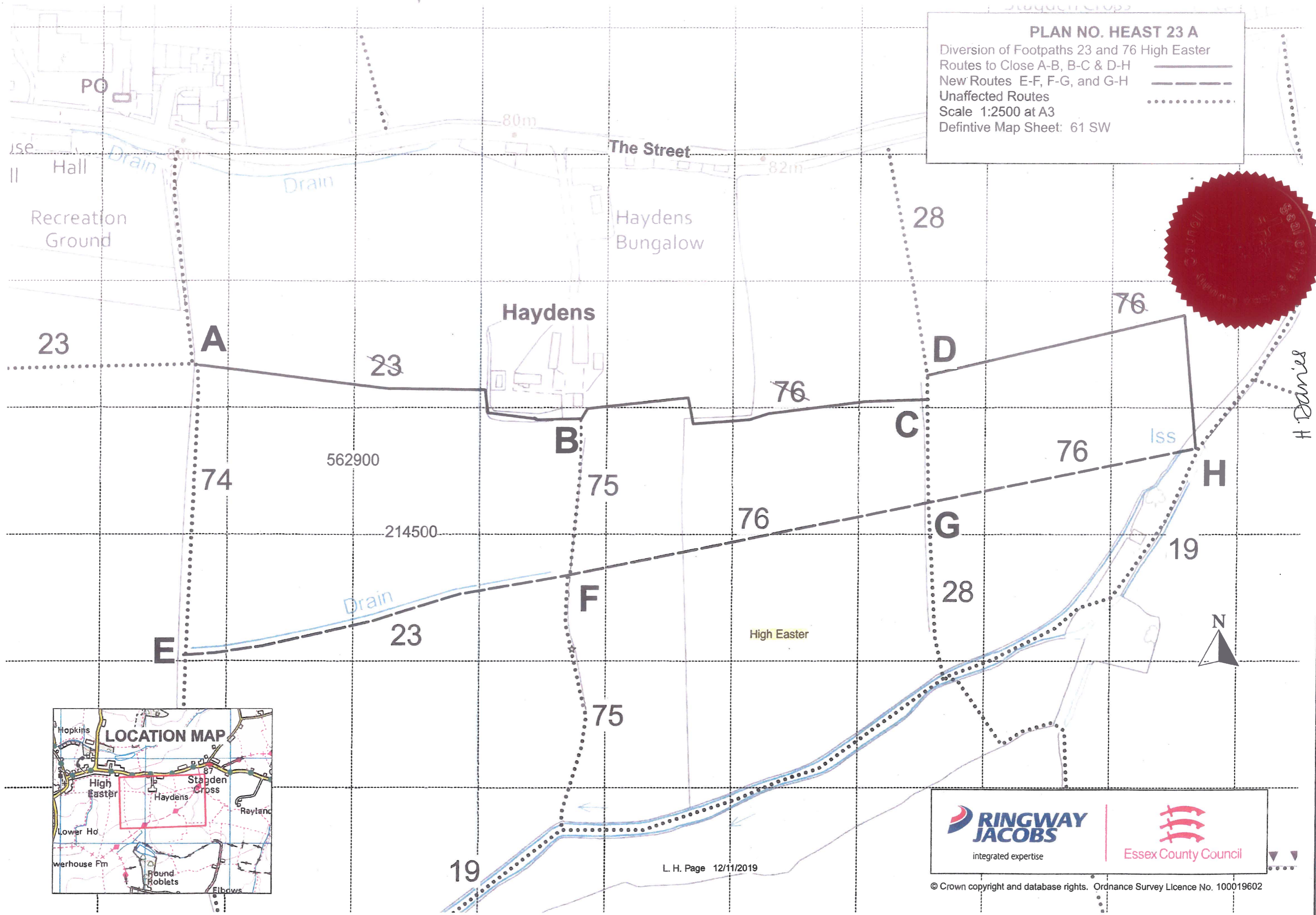
- 1) The public right of ways over the land situated south of the highway The Street known as Footpaths 23 and 76 High Easter in the District of Uttlesford and shown by bold continuous black lines on the order map numbered HEAST 23A contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
  
- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public footpaths over land situated south of the highway The Street known as Footpaths 23 and 76 High Easter in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken black line on the order map numbered HEAST 23A contained in this order.

## SCHEDULE

### (PART 1)

#### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

##### Footpath 23 High Easter

A part length of Footpath 23 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 56277,21463 south east of the High Easter Recreation Ground running in a generally easterly direction south of Haydens Farm for a total distance of approximately 320 metres to point **B** at grid reference 56308,21459 where it connects to Footpath 75 High Easter.

##### Footpath 76 High Easter

(i) A part length of Footpath 76 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from the aforementioned point **B** running in a generally easterly direction across the field for a total distance of approximately 294 metres to point **C** at grid reference 56335,21460 where it connects to Footpath 28 High Easter.

(ii) A further part length of Footpath 76 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **D** at grid reference 56335,21462 running in an east north easterly direction across the field then in a southerly direction for a total distance of approximately 310 metres to point **H** at grid reference 56356,21456 where it connects to Bridleway 19 High Easter.



(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

Footpath 23 High Easter

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at point **E** at grid reference 56276,21440 running in an east north easterly direction on the south side of the ditch for a total distance of approximately 308 metres to point **F** at grid reference 56307,21446 where it connects to Footpath 75 High Easter.

Footpath 76 High Easter

(i) A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing from the aforementioned point **F** running in an east north easterly direction across the field for a total distance of approximately 287 metres to point **G** at grid reference 56335,21452 where it connects to Footpath 28 High Easter.

(ii) A further section of Footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing from the aforementioned point **G** running in an east north easterly direction across the field for a total distance of approximately 218 metres to the aforementioned point **H**.
